CONFIDANT

Parts of Speech: Noun

Meaning: A confidant is someone in whom you

have complete confidence and trust.

Synonyms: ally, advisor.

Antonyms: betrayer, adversary

Sentence: A loyal confidant can be an invaluable

source of emotional support during challenging

times.

SMACK

Parts of Speech: Noun

Meaning: a sharp, resounding noise or the sound of something hitting or being struck.

Synonyms: Crack, snap, pop, clap.

Antonyms: Silence, quiet, hush.

Synonyms: Abhorrent, revolting


Antonyms: Pleasant, agreeable
