**Meaning** : the state of being involved in a wrongful act or illegal activity as an accomplice or partner.

**Synonyms** : Conspiracy ,

# MULLING

Meaning : **the act of deep and careful thought or consideration.**

Synonyms : **Ruminating ,  
Meditating**

Antonyms : **Rushing , Neglecting**





# HOAX

Meaning : a deceptive or misleading act or scheme intended to trick, deceive, or fool people into believing something false or untrue.

Synonyms : Deception, fraud, trick

Antonyms : Truth, authenticity, sincerity





# BURNIS

Meaning **H** to polish, shine, or make something smooth and shiny, typically by rubbing or buffing it.

Synonyms: **Buff , Smooth**

Antonyms: **Corrode , Rust**







# REPOSITOR

Meaning: **to store and organize a collection of items, such as data, documents, or objects, in a systematic manner.**

Synonyms: **Vaults , Collections**

Antonyms: **Ejectors , Dispensers**







# SCIO

Meaning : **N**a descendant or heir, especially a young one who is expected to continue a family's legacy, often in terms of wealth, status, or a particular tradition or business.

Synonyms: **Inheritor** , **Progeny**

Antonyms: **Forbear** , **Ancestor**





# SABOTAGE

Meaning : **to deliberately destroy, damage, or disrupt something, such as a plan, project, relationship, or process, often for malicious or self-serving reasons.**

Synonyms: **Subvert , Wreck**

Antonyms: **Assist , Foster**

Meaning : **Very complicated, detailed, or complex in structure or design**

Synonyms : **Complex , Intricacy**

Antonyms : **Simple , Basic**





# BENIG

Meaning: **Something that is not harmful, threatening, or malignant.**

Synonyms : **Benevolent , Harmless**

Antonyms : **Malicious , Hostile**





# EMASCULATED

Meaning : **The act of making someone feel less confident or less like a man.**

Synonyms : **Weaken , Castrate**

Antonyms : **Vitalize , Assert**





# SYNAGOG

**Meaning** **DEF** A building or place where Jewish people gather for religious services, prayer, and community activities.

**Synonyms** : Temple , Shul

## ON

Meaning : **A deviation from a moral or ethical standard.**

Synonyms: **Anomaly , Oddity**

Antonyms: **Consistency , Standard**







# STEWARDS

Meaning: **HI** The responsible and ethical management, care, and protection of something that has been entrusted to one's care.

Synonyms: Custodian , Oversight

Antonyms: Squander ,  
Abandonment





# SHODD

Meaning : Noun: **Something of low quality or inferior workmanship.**

Adj. **poor quality, cheaply made, or badly constructed**

Synonyms: **Inferior , Cheap**

Antonyms: **Superior , Excellent**





# RESCIND

**ED**  
Meaning : **To revoke, cancel, or annul a decision, order, or agreement.**

Synonyms : **repeal, withdraw**

Antonyms : **Enact, implement, establish**

Meaning : **used in the context of legal motions, hearings, or orders.**

Synonyms : **One -sidedly**

Antonyms : **Mutually**





# SCRAMBLE

Meaning : **To move or climb quickly and with difficulty, often in a disorderly or hasty manner.**

Synonyms : **Scuttle , Clamber**

Antonyms : **Neaten , Systemize**





# STIMULU

Meaning : **Something that excites or arouses activity or energy in a person**

Synonyms : **Trigger , Impetus**

Antonyms : **Hindrance , Inhibition**





# TUMBL

Meaning: **To move or cause to move in a disorderly or chaotic way.**

Synonyms: **Plunge , Topple**

Antonyms: **Increase , Climb**







# PROFUNDI

**Meaning:** The quality or state of being profound or deep, especially in terms of intellectual depth, insight, or seriousness.

**Synonyms:** Wisdom , Erudition

**Antonyms:** Banality , Triviality





# STAGGER

Meaning: **Verb : to walk or move unsteadily**

Adj. **difficult to believe or comprehend due to its enormity or impact.**

Synonyms: **Astounding , Incredible**

Antonyms: **Paltry , Mundane**





# STIFF

Meaning : Noun: **a dead body, especially one prepared for burial.**

Adj. **Difficult to bend or move.**

Synonyms: **Rigid , Stern**

Antonyms: **Lax , Supple**





# VITUPERATIO

Meaning : **harsh, abusive, or vehement language or criticism**

Synonyms : **Invective , Censure**

Antonyms : **Admiration , Applause**





# BIVOUA

Meaning : **a temporary camp or shelter, typically for military troops or mountaineers, often without the use of tents or other permanent structures.**

Synonyms : **Shelter , Halt , Lodge**

Antonyms : **Residence ,  
Evacuate**





# AVERR

Meaning **ED** To assert or affirm something with confidence, to declare or state positively, or to express a belief or opinion firmly and confidently.

Synonyms : Asserted , Declared

Antonyms : Refuted , Negated





# INFILTRATO

Meaning **RS** individuals or groups who secretly enter a place, organization, or group with the intent of gaining information, causing disruption, or carrying out activities without detection or authorization.

Synonyms: Intruders , Saboteurs

Antonyms: Allies , Supporters







# ABDUCT

**Meaning** The criminal act of forcefully taking someone against their will, often for ransom or other malicious purposes.

**Synonyms :** Hypothesis ,  
Surmise , Snatching

**Antonyms :** Fact , Evidence





# AMORPHO

Meaning : **Something lacking a definite or organized shape or structure**

Synonyms : **Nebulous , Vague**

Antonyms : **Crystalline , Distinct**





# ESPOU

Meaning **SAL** The act of adopting, supporting, or endorsing a particular idea, cause, belief, or policy.

Synonyms: Endorsement , backing

Antonyms: Dissent , Denial





# STOK

**Meaning** : the act of encouraging or intensifying something, such as emotions, tensions, or conflicts.

**Synonyms**: Inflammate , Exacerbate

**Antonyms**: Pacify , Mitigate





# HANKERIN

Meaning : **a strong, persistent desire or craving for something, often something specific or particular.**

Synonyms: **Craving , Yearning**

Antonyms: **Aversion , Disgust**





# STRIFE

Meaning : **disputes, disagreements, or hostility, and can result in tension or even physical confrontations.**

Synonyms : **contention, rivalry**

Antonyms : **Harmony, peace, cooperation**
