CORPUS(NOUN)

Meaning : a collection or body of written or spoken material, often used for linguistic analysis or research.

Synonyms: Assemblage , Aggregation

Antonyms: Scattering , Disarray

Sentence : The company maintains a digital corpus of customer feedback to improve its products and services.



STEADFAST(adj.)

faithful

Meaning : **a person who is resolute, unwavering, and firmly committed to their beliefs or decisions, regardless of challenges or difficulties.**

Synonyms: **Resolute, Devoted**

Antonyms: **Fickle, Wavering.**

Sentence : **Even in the face of criticism, she remained steadfast in her decision to follow her passion.**



Replenished

REPLENISHED (verb)

Meaning : **It means to fill or make complete again by adding more of something.**

Synonyms: **Recharged , Reinvigorated**

Antonyms: **depleted , exhausted**

Sentence : **The rain replenished the reservoir, bringing relief to the drought-stricken region.**



PEDANTIC (adj.)

✓
Meaning : being overly concerned with formal rules, details, and minor points of learning or knowledge

Synonyms: Nitpicking , Precise

Antonyms: Casual , Relaxed

Sentence : The pedantic tone of the presentation made it difficult for the audience to stay engaged.



BUOYED (verb)

Meaning : to keep afloat or support.

Synonyms: Elevated , Boosted

Antonyms: Deflated , Sunk

Sentence : She felt buoyed by the kind words and gestures of her friends during a difficult time.



HALVING (noun)

Meaning : The action or process of dividing something into two equal parts.

Synonyms: dividing , Splitting

Antonyms: Increasing , Augmenting

Sentence : The halving of the cake was done carefully to ensure equal portions for everyone.



DEEM(VERB)

Meaning : to express an assessment or belief about a particular situation or thing.

Synonyms: Judge , Believe , Esteem.

Antonyms: Disregard , Ignore , Reject

Sentence : After careful examination, the professor deemed the research paper worthy of publication.



STEWARDSHIP(NOUN)

Meaning : the responsible management and care of something entrusted to one's care, often involving the protection and sustainable use of resources.

Synonyms: Responsibility, Custodianship, Guardianship, Oversight

Antonyms: Negligence, Irresponsibility, Mismanagement, Exploitation

Sentence : Sarah took on the stewardship of the company's finances, ensuring that resources were used wisely and responsibly.



SANS(NOUN)

Meaning : refers to the System Administration, Networking, and Security Institute, which is known for its cybersecurity training and certifications.

Synonyms: Lacking , devoid
