# VOCABULARY



#### EPIDEMIOLOGIC (ADJ.)

Meaning: Pertaining to epidemiology, which involves the study of the patterns, causes, and effects of health and disease conditions in defined populations.

Synonyms: health-related, population-based

Antonyms: individual-focused

Sentence: The epidemiologic investigation revealed a significant increase in the incidence of a rare disease in the local population.



## STRIKING(adj.)

Meaning: Attracting attention or notice due to being unusual, remarkable, or impressive. Synonyms: eye-catching, notable, conspicuous Antonyms: Ordinary, unremarkable, commonplace Sentence: The artist's striking use of color and form captivated everyone who entered the



### **OUTPATIENT(NOUN)**

Meaning: A patient who receives medical treatment without being admitted to a hospital.

Synonyms: Ambulatory patient, day patient

Antonyms: non-admitted, non-residential

Sentence: The new clinic specializes in outpatient care, providing medical services to individuals without requiring them to stay overnight in a hospital.



## CRUX(noun)

Meaning: The central or most important point; the essential or decisive element of something. Synonyms: Core, essence, heart, nucleus, key point

Antonyms: Periphery, fringe, superficiality

Sentence: The crux of the matter was that effective communication was necessary for the success of the project.



## TENET(noun)

Meaning: A principle or belief, especially one of the main principles of a religion or philosophy.

Synonyms: Doctrine, dogma, principle, belief, creed

Antonyms: Heresy, disbelief, dissent

Sentence: The tenet of the organization is to promote equality and social justice for all members of the community.



### RECONVENED(NOUN)

Meaning: To convene or assemble again, especially after a break or adjournment.

Synonyms: reassembled, regathered

Antonyms: Adjourned, dispersed, disbanded

Sentence: After a short recess, the meeting reconvened to discuss the remaining agenda items.



### PROROGUED(VERB)

Meaning: To discontinue a session of a legislative body without dissolving it; to temporarily suspend or postpone.

Synonyms: Postponed, suspended, deferred,

adjourned

Antonyms: Convened, resumed, continued

Sentence: The parliament prorogued its session due to unforeseen circumstances, with plans to reconvene in a month.



#### DIVESTED(ADJ.)

Meaning: To strip or deprive someone or something of certain attributes, possessions, or characteristics.

Synonyms: dispossessed, unloaded, sold off

Antonyms: Endowed, invested, adorned, retained

Sentence: The company divested itself of noncore businesses in order to focus on its primary strengths and improve profitability.
