Prance (Verb) : उछल-कूद

RAMS(Noun)

Meaning: A heavy object used to break down doors or walls in ancient warfare.

WAFTS(Noun, verb)



Meaning: To float or be carried gently through the air, often with a pleasant smell or sound.

HEIST(Noun , Verb)



Meaning: A robbery or theft, especially one involving a significant amount of money, valuable items, or a large-scale operation.

TURPITUDE



Meaning : **Morally reprehensible or disgraceful behavior or character.**

SNAGS

Meaning : **A complication or problem that causes a delay or difficulty.**
