Parts of Speech : **Adj.**

Meaning : **Relating to or resulting from human activities, particularly those that have a significant impact on the natural environment, climate, or ecosystem.**

Synonyms : **Man-made**

Antonyms : **Organic, Wild**

Sentence : **The construction of the dam was criticized for its significant anthropogenic impact on the local ecosystem and wildlife.**

Sentence : **It took him a while to assimilate the complex scientific concepts, but with time and effort, he mastered them.**

DUTIFUL

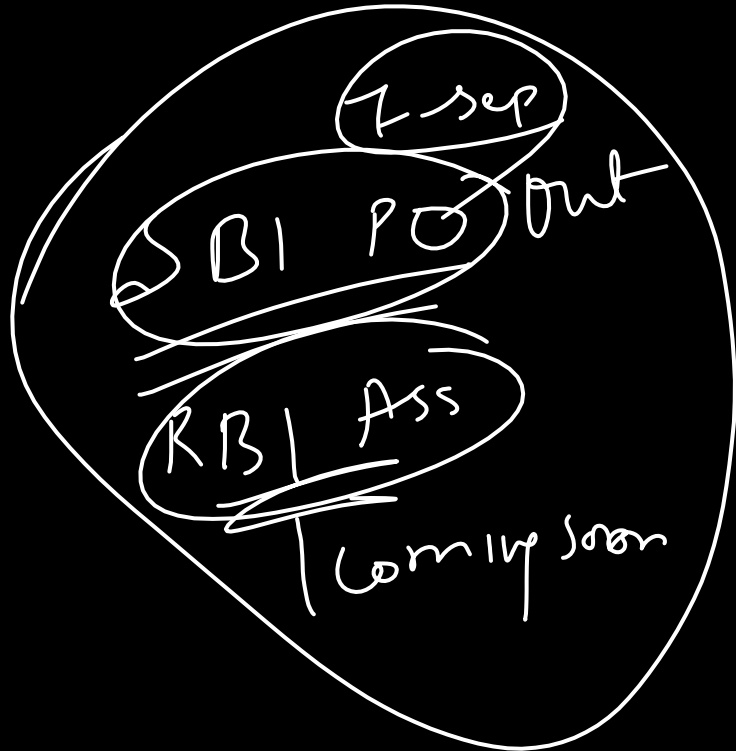
Parts of Speech : **Adj.**
