

ABROGATION


Parts of Speech: Noun

Parts of Speech : Adj.

Meaning: Relating to or resulting from human activities, particularly those that have a significant impact on the natural environment, climate, or ecosystem.

Synonyms : Man-made

Sentence: The construction of the dam was criticized for its significant anthropogenic impact on the local ecosystem and wildlife.

Antonyms: Xegligent, Rebellious


