EXAM BASED WORDS



Contraries (noun)

Meaning : **something that is as different as possible from something else**

Synonyms : **negatives, opposites, inverses**

Antonyms : **counterparts, copies, duplicates**

Sentence : **She said that dreams go by contraries.**



Resilience (noun)

Meaning : **the ability of something to return to its original shape after it has been stretched, pressed, bent, etc.**

Synonyms : **flexibility, adaptability, elasticity**

Antonyms : **stiffness, rigidity, inflexibility**

Sentence : **Palm trees have evolved to show strong resilience in the face of tropical storms.**



Tizzy (noun)

Meaning : a state of nervous or irritated concern.

Synonyms : panic, huff, fuss

Antonyms : joy, calm, cheer

Sentence : All in a tizzy because she can't find her car keys



Hubristic (adj.)

Meaning : **exaggerated pride or self-confidence**

Synonyms : **egocentric, narcissistic, self-satisfied**

Antonyms : **bashful, lowly, self-doubting**

Sentence : **A hubristic belief in his own self-proclaimed genius**



Curbing (verb)

Constrain
Suppressing
Oppressing
Impeding
Smothering
Muzzling

Meaning : **to keep from exceeding a desirable degree or level**

Synonyms : **regulating, controlling, restraining**

Antonyms : **losing, loosening, liberating** / Encouragement

Sentence : **Police are looking for ways of curbing the traffic of guns.**



Chores (noun)

Meaning : a piece of work that needs to be done regularly

Synonyms: **jobs, duties, responsibilities**

*duty or task
that is often unpleasant
but necessary*

Sentence : Everyone in this household is expected to do weekly chores



Hobby

Recreational (adj.)

3m colage

Meaning : **as in comic**

Synonyms: **entertaining, humorous, fun**

Antonyms: **uninteresting, boring, pedestrian**

Sentence : **Lucien was never invited to participate in recreational activities.**



Basking (verb)

Meaning : **as in resting**

Synonyms: **resting, relaxing, reposing**

Antonyms: **laboring, toiling, struggling**

*Pleasant
warmth*

Sentence : **We blissfully basked at the seashore over the long holiday.**



Hoard (verb)

Noun – a store
food.

Verb – to collect or
to store
गुप्तार

Meaning : to put (something of future use or value) in a safe or secret place.

Synonyms: collect, store, treasure

Antonyms: ditch, consume, discard

Sentence : They've begun to hoard food and gas online and save their money.



Explicitly (adj)

Hoard – Noun
A large hoard^{or} of coins^N
was found in 1991

Meaning : so clearly expressed as to leave no doubt about the meaning

Synonyms: **unmistakable, specific, unambiguous**

Antonyms: ambiguous, implied, unspecific

Sentence : Explicit instructions about what to do in an emergency.

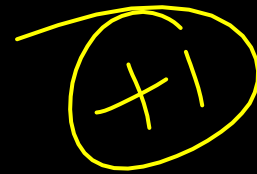
