

1. Grasssroots (Noun) : आधार

Meaning: The common or ordinary people at a local level

Synonyms: Commoners masses, public, populace, community. Population Antonyms: Elite, aristocracy, upper class

Sentence: The grassroots played a significant role in organizing the protest.



Grasssroots peace: on the local body elections in West Bengal

Free and fair elections to local bodies are not possible without peace

2. Watchdog (Noun): चौकीदार


Meaning: A person or organization that acts as a guardian or protector, especially in monitoring and ensuring accountability of others.

Synonyms: Guardian, custodian, overseer, monitor.

Antonyms: Offender, wrongdoer, culprit, lawbreaker.

Sentence: The media serves as a watchdog to hold the government accountable for its actions.





3. Fracas (Noun): कोलाहल

Meaning: a noisy disturbance or quarrel.

Synonyms: quarrel, scuffle, brawl

Antonyms: truce

Sentence: Eight people were injured in the fracas.




4. Jamboree (Noun) : उत्सव

Meaning: a large celebration or party, typically a lavish and boisterous one.

Synonyms: rally, gathering, gettogether

Sentence: The film industry's annual jamboree was in Cannes.



5. Grapple (Verb): लड़ना, संघर्ष करना

Meaning: To struggle or wrestle with something or someone, to engage in a close fight or struggle without weapons.

Synonyms: Wrestle, fight, struggle, tussle, contend, combat

Antonyms: Surrender, give up

Sentence: The athlete had to grapple with his opponent for nearly ten minutes before finally winning the wrestling match.



6. Kudos (Noun) : सम्मान, प्रशंसा Heaning: Praise and recognition for an achievement or accomplishment.

Synonyms: Acclaim, applause

Antonyms: Criticism, condemnation, disapproval

Sentence: The singer received kudos from the audience for his outstanding performance at the concert.






7. Covenant (Noun) : अनुबंध

Meaning: a formal and binding agreement or contract between two or more parties

Synonyms: agreement, contract, treaty, pact, deal, bond, commitment

Antonyms: disagreement, discord, denial, breach

Sentence: They signed a covenant agreeing to share the profits equally .





8. Remorseful (Adj.) : पश्चातापी

Meaning: Feeling or expressing sincere regret or remorse (a feeling of sadness and being sorry for something you have done)

Synonyms: repentant, contrite, apologetic, regretful, sorry, ashamed

Antonyms: unrepentant, impenitent, shameless, unashamed

Sentence: After realizing the harm he had caused, he was remorseful and apologized to those he had hurt.





9. Travail (Noun) : कड़ा परिश्रम

Meaning: painful or laborious effort, a physical or mental exertion

Synonyms: toil, labor, effort, exertion, struggle

Antonyms: ease, rest, leisure, relaxation

Sentence: She went through much travail to become a doctor.





10. Desiccated (Adj.): सुखाया हुआ

Meaning: remove the moisture from (something); cause it to become completely dry; lacking vitality or interest

Synonyms: dried up, dehydrated, lifeless

Antonyms: hydrated, moist, wet, juicy

Sentence: After sitting in the hot sun all day, the once lush green grass had become desiccated and brown.





11. Taciturn (Adjective) : अल्पभाषी

Meaning: reserved or uncommunicative in speech; tending not to speak much

Synonyms: untalkative, uncommunicative, reticent

Antonyms: blabby, chatty, talkative

Sentence: John is a taciturn man who rarely speaks more than a few words at a time.



12. Intent (Noun/Adj.) : इरादा, उद्देश्य

Meaning: (adj) having the mind or attention firmly fixed on something; (n) intention or purpose

Synonyms: aim, goal, objective, purpose, attentive, focused

Antonyms: aimless, unfocused, distracted

Sentence: The athlete had an intent look on his face as he prepared for the race.



🔊 13. Canard (Noun): झूठी खबर, धोखा

Meaning: false or baseless, usually a derogatory story, report, or rumor, misleading statement (intended to deceive people)

Synonyms: falsehood, rumor, hoax, fabrication, myth, lie

Antonyms: truth, fact, reality



Sentence: The politician was known for spreading canards about his opponents to gain an advantage in the election.




