







REMISSION(NOUN)



Meaning: the temporary or permanent reduction or disappearance of the symptoms of a disease Synonyms: Improvement, alleviation, abatement, lessening, mitigation. Antonyms: Worsening, exacerbation, deterioration.

Sentence:

The patient experienced a period of remission after

undergoing successful treatment for cancer.



SEARING(ADJ.)

something extremely hot, burning, **Meaning:** or intense, often related to heat or pain.. Synonyms: Scorching, burning, blistering, intense. Antonyms: Cool, mild, gentle. amper. **Example Sentence:** The searing heat of the desert made the journey extremely challenging.



INDICTMENT (NOUN)

Meaning: a formal accusation or charge of a serious

crime.

Synonyms: Accusation, charge, allegation,

prosecution, indictment.

Antonyms: Acquittal, exoneration, vindication.

Sentence:

The grand jury issued an indictment against the

suspect for embezzlement.



QUASHING(VERB)

Meaning: the act of suppressing, nullifying, or overturning a legal decision, order, or indictment. Synonyms: Overturning, nullifying, annulling, cancelling, revoking. Antonyms: Upholding, confirming, endorsing.

Sentence:

The appellate court is considering quashing the lower

court's decision due to procedural errors.



GARLAND (NOUN & VERB)

Meaning: a decorative wreath or cord, typically

there on ER made of flowers, leaves, or other materials, worn as

an ornament or hung for festive occasions.

Synonyms: Wreath, lei, festoon, decoration.

Verb:)Decorate, adorn, festoon.

Antonyms: Bareness, simplicity.

Verb: Undecorate, strip, bare..

Sentence: The room was adorned with colorful

garlands in celebration of the festival.

Verb: The entrance was garlanded with ribbons and

flowers for the grand opening.

TANDEM(NOUN & ADJ.)

Meaning: a_barrangement or structure in which two things are positioned one behind the other, often in a line or a sequence.

Synonyms: Pair, duo, combination, sequence.

Antonyms: Individual, solo, single.

Sentence: Noun: They rode the tandem bicycle

together, pedaling in perfect sync.

- The tandem performance by the musicians

captivated the audience.



COMPLICIT (ADJ.)

Meaning: the involvement or participation of an

individual in a wrongful or illegal act, often implying

that they are aware of the wrongdoing but choose to be a

part of it.

Synonyms: Collusive, involved, accomplice,

conspiratorial.

Antonyms: Uninvolved, innocent, unaware.

Sentence:

The employees were complicit in the embezzlement

scheme, knowingly assisting in the financial fraud.

USURPATION(NOUN)

Meaning: the act of wrongfully taking someone's position, power, or rights by force or without proper authority. Synonyms: Seizure, appropriation, takeover,

infringement.

Antonyms: Legitimate accession, rightful succession,

surrender.

Sentence:

The people protested against the usurpation of their

democratic rights by the authoritarian regime.



OMNIBUS(NOUN)



Meaning: <u>a large volume or collection that</u> contains a variety of items, often related to a particular subject or theme.

Synonyms: Compilation, collection, anthology,

compendium.

Antonyms: Individual, single item, separate

publication.

Sentence: We took the omnibus to explore the city,

hopping on and off at different landmarks.
