# Controvert



**Parts of Speech :** Verb

**Meaning :** To say or prove that something is not true

**Sentence :** The attorney offered evidence that controverted the plaintiff's allegations.

**Synonyms :** Contradict , Confound

**Antonyms :** Approve , Corroborate



# DEFLATED

Parts of Speech : **Verb**

Meaning : **To let air or gas out of a tire, balloon, etc.**

Sentence : **His car tyres were deflated soon after he left for work.**

Synonyms : **Flatten , Puncture**

Antonyms : **Inflate , Blow up**



## RAMPANT

Uncontrollable

Parts of Speech : **Adjective**

Meaning : **Existing or spreading everywhere in a way that cannot be controlled**

Sentence : **Unemployment is now rampant in most of the countries**

Synonyms : **Epidemic , Widespread**

Antonyms : **Moderate , Limited**





## NIGGARDLY



Parts of Speech : **Adjective**

Meaning : **Unwilling to be generous with money, time, etc.**

Sentence : **He was such a niggard that he would not pay for his daughter's medicine**

Synonyms : **Miserly , Avaricious**

Antonyms : **Generous , Bountiful**



# CARNAGE



Parts of Speech : **Noun**

Meaning : **The violent killing of a large number of people**

Sentence : **There was much carnage on the battlefield.**

Synonyms : **Slaughter, Bloodshed**

Antonyms : **Peace**





## UPHILL : कठिन

Parts of Speech : **Adjective**

Meaning : **Needing a lot of effort**

Sentence : **The walk from the village to Greystones was uphill all the way.**

Synonyms : **Mounting , Rising**

Antonyms : **Easy , Effortless**

## COLANDER

Atom

Parts of Speech : **Verb**

Meaning : **a metal or plastic bowl with a lot of small holes in it, used for draining water from vegetables, etc. after washing or cooking**

Sentence : **They will drain the pasta in the metal colander.**

Synonyms : **Utensil , Sifter**



# RELISHED

POS: **Verb**

Sentence : **I know that he always relishes the opportunity to answer all the points that have been raised.**



Meaning : **To enjoy something immensely.**

Synonyms: **Appreciate, Savor**

Antonyms: **Apathy, Dislike**



# INFRINGED

POS : **Verb**

Sentence : **They claim that his use of the name infringes their copyright.**



Meaning : **To break a rule, law, agreement**

Synonyms: **Transgress , Contravene**

Antonyms: **Comply , Obey**



# BOISTEROUS

POS : **Adjective**

Sentence : **He was so boisterous at the party that he stole the thunder from the hosts.**

Meaning : **Noisy and full of energy**

Synonyms : **Vociferous , Strident**

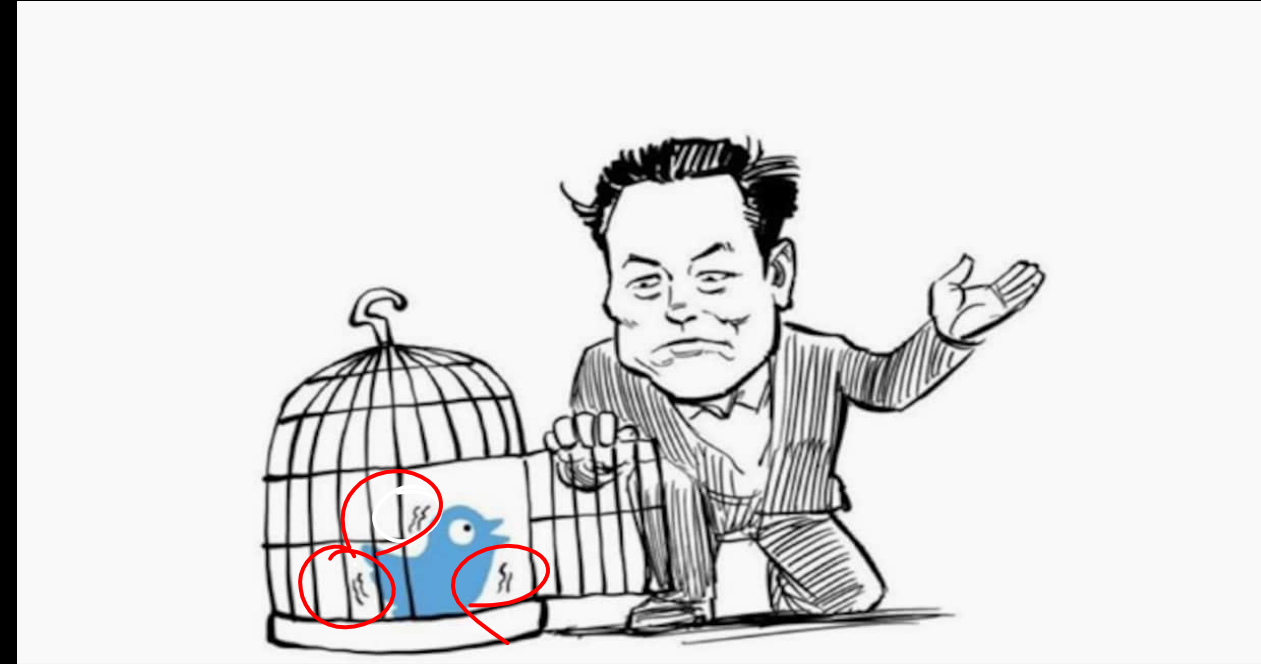
Antonyms : **Low , Quiet**



# DECIPHER

POS : **Verb**

Sentence : I can't decipher what is inscribed on the pillar.



Meaning : **Succeed in reading untidy or careless writing**

Synonyms: **Decode , Decrypt**

Antonyms: **Encode , Encrypt**



# OBLITERATE

POS: **Verb**

Sentence : **She tried to obliterate all memory of her father.**



Meaning : **Destroy something completely**

Synonyms: **Annihilate , Extirpate**

Antonyms: **Revive , Initiate**



**ASPERSION**

negative

POS: **Noun**

Sentence : **I do not permit you to cast aspersions on my friend.**



Meaning : **A disparaging remark**

Synonyms: **Defamation , Abuse**

Antonyms: **Refrain , Defend**





# LAMBASTED



POS: **Verb**

Sentence : **The professor lambasted me for my careless mistake.**

Brutal*

Meaning : **Criticize (someone or something) harshly.**

Synonyms: **Castigate, Criticize**

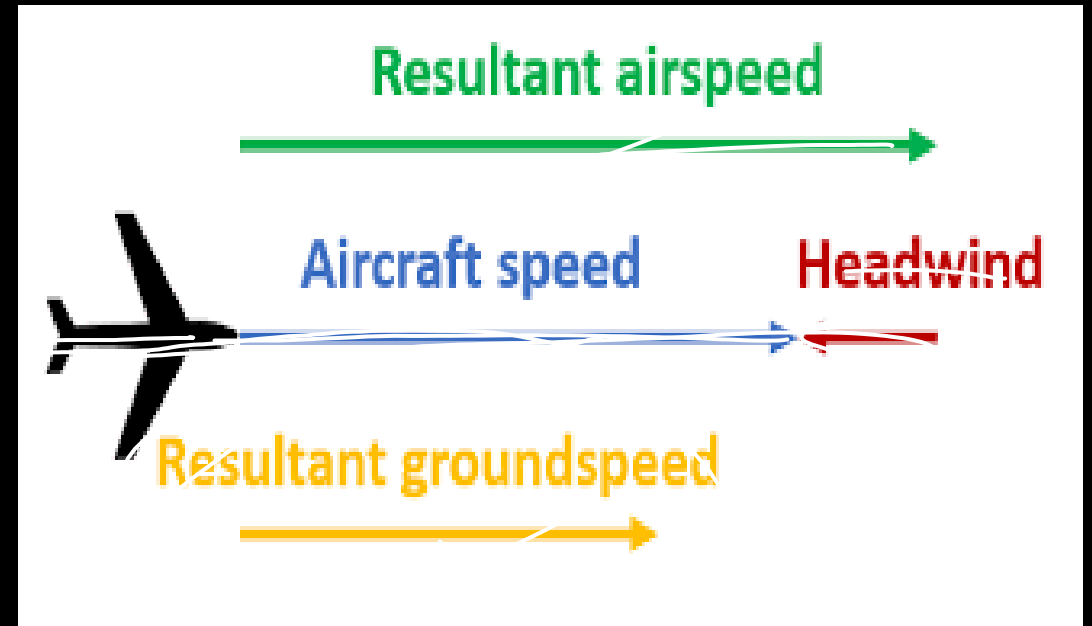
Antonyms: **Compliment, Praise**



# HEADWIND

POS : **Noun**

Sentence : **While the aircraft flew through the air, the strong headwind kept beating harshly against the windshield.**



Meaning : **Wind that blows against you.**

Synonyms: **Flurry , Gale**

Antonyms: **Tailwind , Calm**



10. Slain (Verb) : हत्या कर देना

Meaning: **To kill violently; to murder**

Synonyms: **Slaughtered , Killed**

Antonyms: **Rescued , Protected**

Sentence: The villagers were terrified when they learned that a pack of wolves had slain their livestock.





1. **LURCH** (Noun, Verb) : लुढ़कना

**Meaning:** A sudden movement forward or to one side

**Synonyms:** Wobble, Totter

**Antonyms:** Steady

**Sentence:** The ship experienced a dangerous lurch when it encountered strong waves.



4. ACCLIMATISED (Adj.) : ~~ACCLIMATED~~

**Meaning:** To get used to a new climate, a new situation, etc.

**Synonyms:** Adapted, Adjusted

**Antonyms:** Unfamiliar, Unaccustomed

**Sentence:** She quickly acclimatized to the fast-paced city life after moving from a small town.





## 5. CHAFE(Noun)

**Meaning:** The act or result of irritating or rubbing the skin, causing discomfort, soreness, or irritation.

**Synonyms:** Abrasion, Discomfort

**Antonyms:** Soothing, Comforting

**Sentence:** The athlete wore special clothing to prevent chafing during the marathon.





6. RAMPAGE (Noun, Verb): **कोधपूर्ण आचरण**



**Meaning:** A violent or frenzied behavior, often involving wild and uncontrollable actions of destruction or aggression.

**Synonyms:** Tumult, Mayhem, Uproar

**Antonyms:** Control, Restrain

**Sentence:** The protestors went on a rampage, looting and vandalizing shops in the city.
