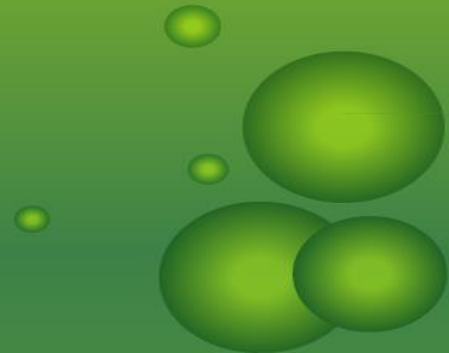


WHAT IS ADJECTIVE :-



Types of adjectives :-

1. Adjective of quality
2. Proper adjective
3. Adjective of number
4. Demonstrative adjective
5. Distributive adjective
6. Interrogative adjective
7. Adjective of quantity
8. Possessive adjective



WAY OF USAGE

ATTRIBUTIVE:

Adjective that comes before a noun is called an attributive adjective.

Examples:

a **leafless** tree

a **tight** dress

a **well-stocked** shop

PREDICATIVE:

Adjective that comes after a noun is called a predicative adjective.

Examples:

The scream was **loud**.

The sky looks **dark**.

The villagers **were friendly** towards us.

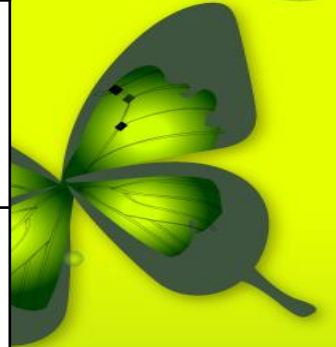

great	greater	greatest

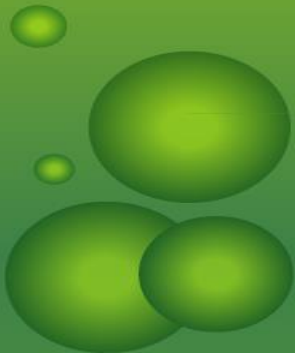
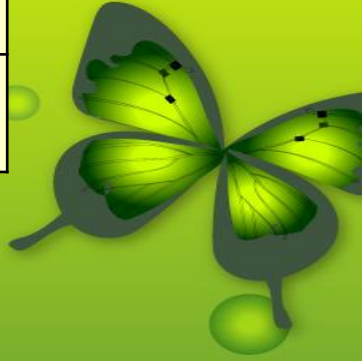
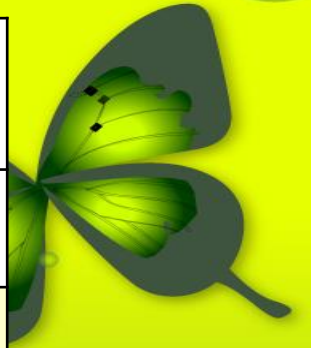
**By deleting the final 'y' and adding 'ier' and

easy	easier	easiest



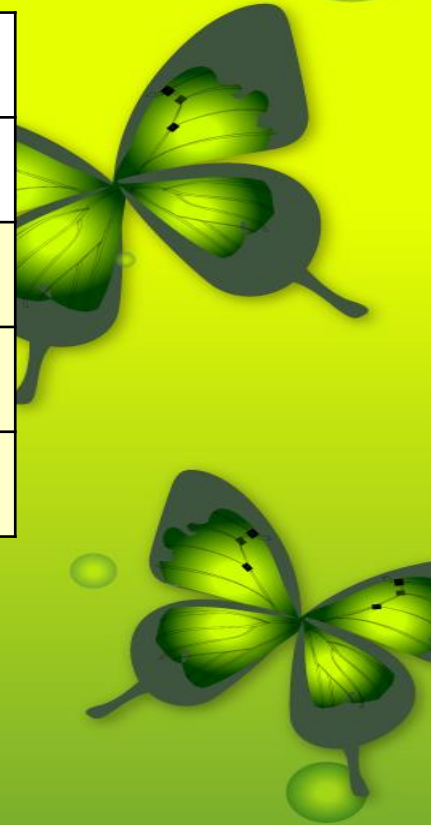
By adding 'r' and 'st'

large	larger	largest



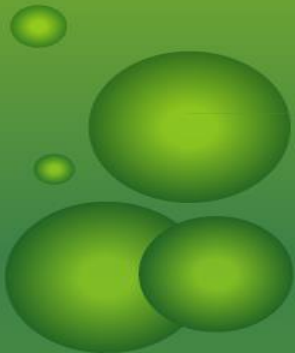
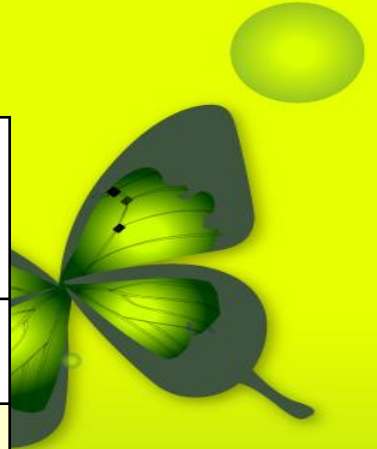
By repeating the final consonants

(for double of more syllable words)**

RULE :-

The following adjectives are followed by 'to' and not by 'than'.

junior, senior, inferior, prefer, preferable, superior, elder , prior etc



- **He is senior than me .**
- **My sister is elder than me.**
- **Mr . sharma is more senior than her boss in service .**
- **Lemon juice is preferable than tea .**
- **Milk is more preferable to tea.**
