- 4) Direction, Religious books , Nationality , community , commission , committee.*
- 5) Musical instruments , names of inventions, before group of singers .*
- 6) Political parties, historical monuments, historical event , historical dynasty , historical caste ,historical empire .*

*9) Superlative degree , ordinals ,unique things ,parts of body .*

*11) NOUN + OF +NOUN , HERE before first noun ,always use "THE Article "*

*12) When an ADJECTIVE is used as a Noun ," THE ARTICLE " is used before it .*
