adamant :- very sure; refusing to change your mind

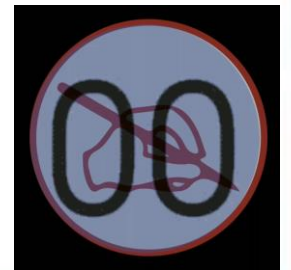

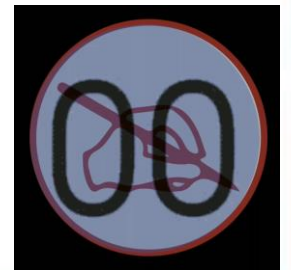

taciturn ; - less talkative

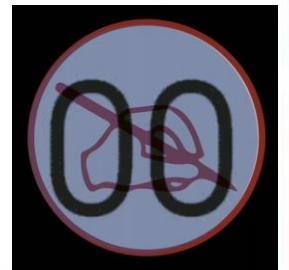

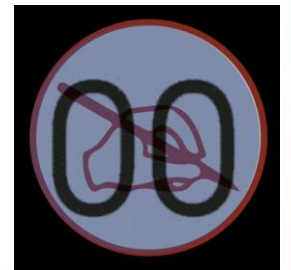
