*It expresses situations in which one thing automatically happens after the other*

*In this case both clauses remain in simple present tense .*

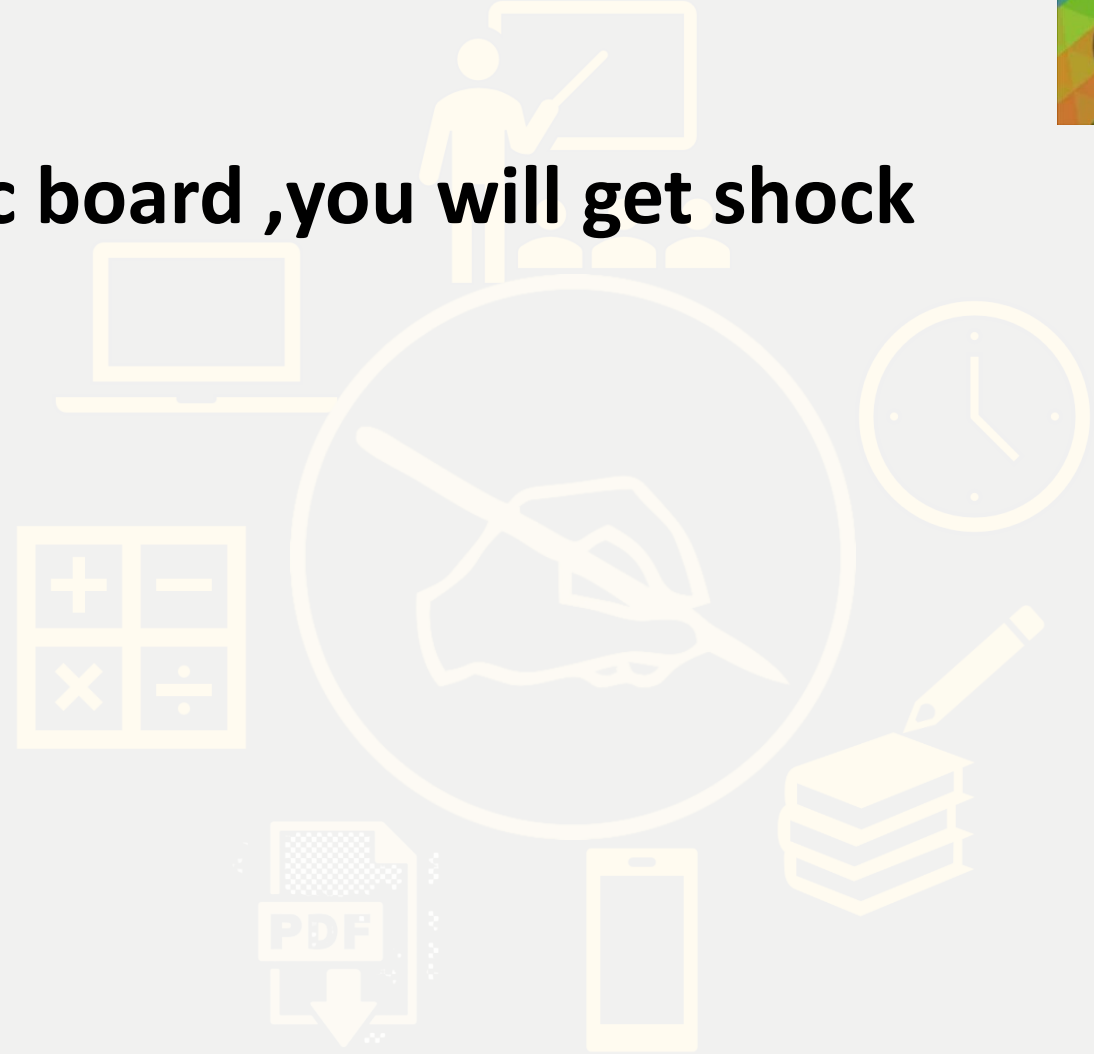




## First conditional

*( if this happens , that will happen )*

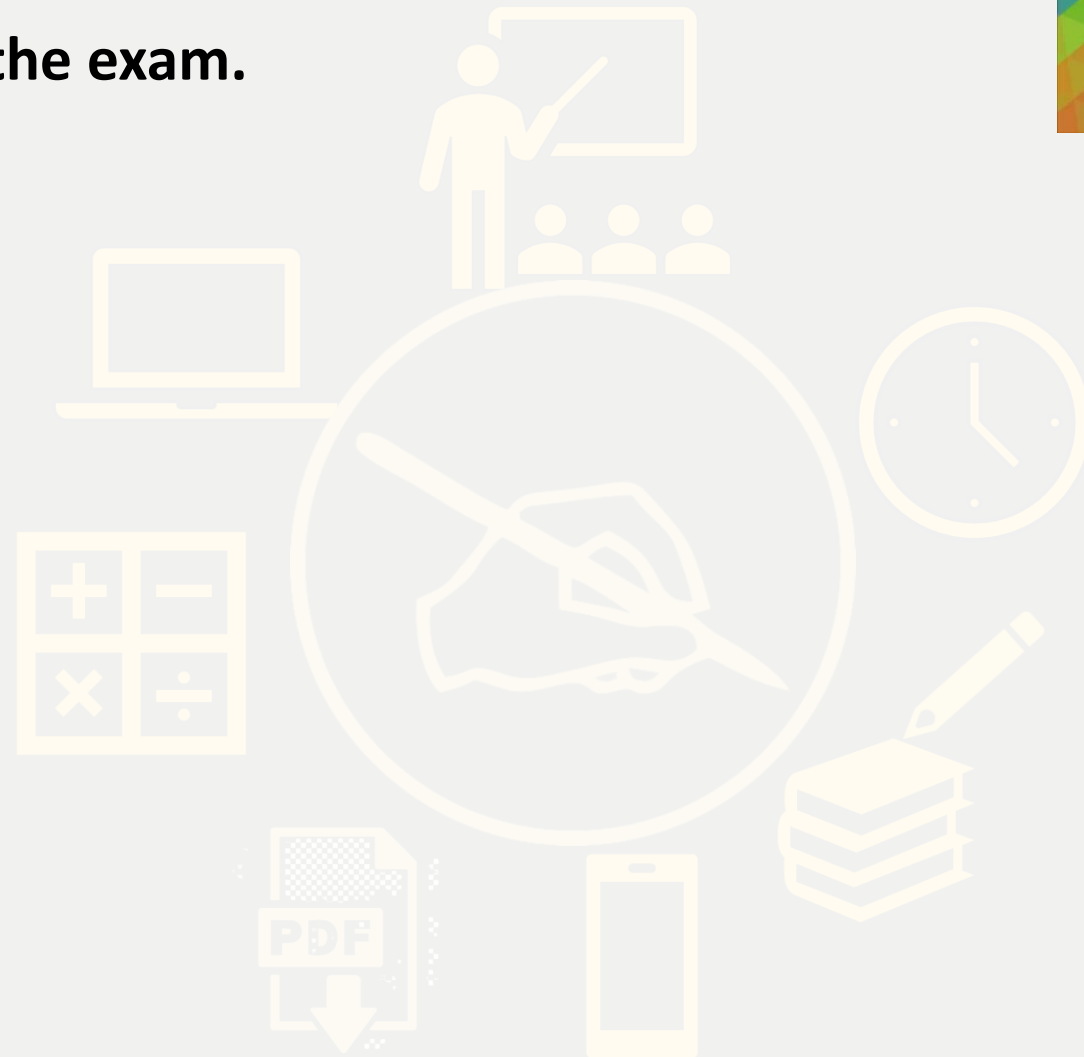

# Second conditional

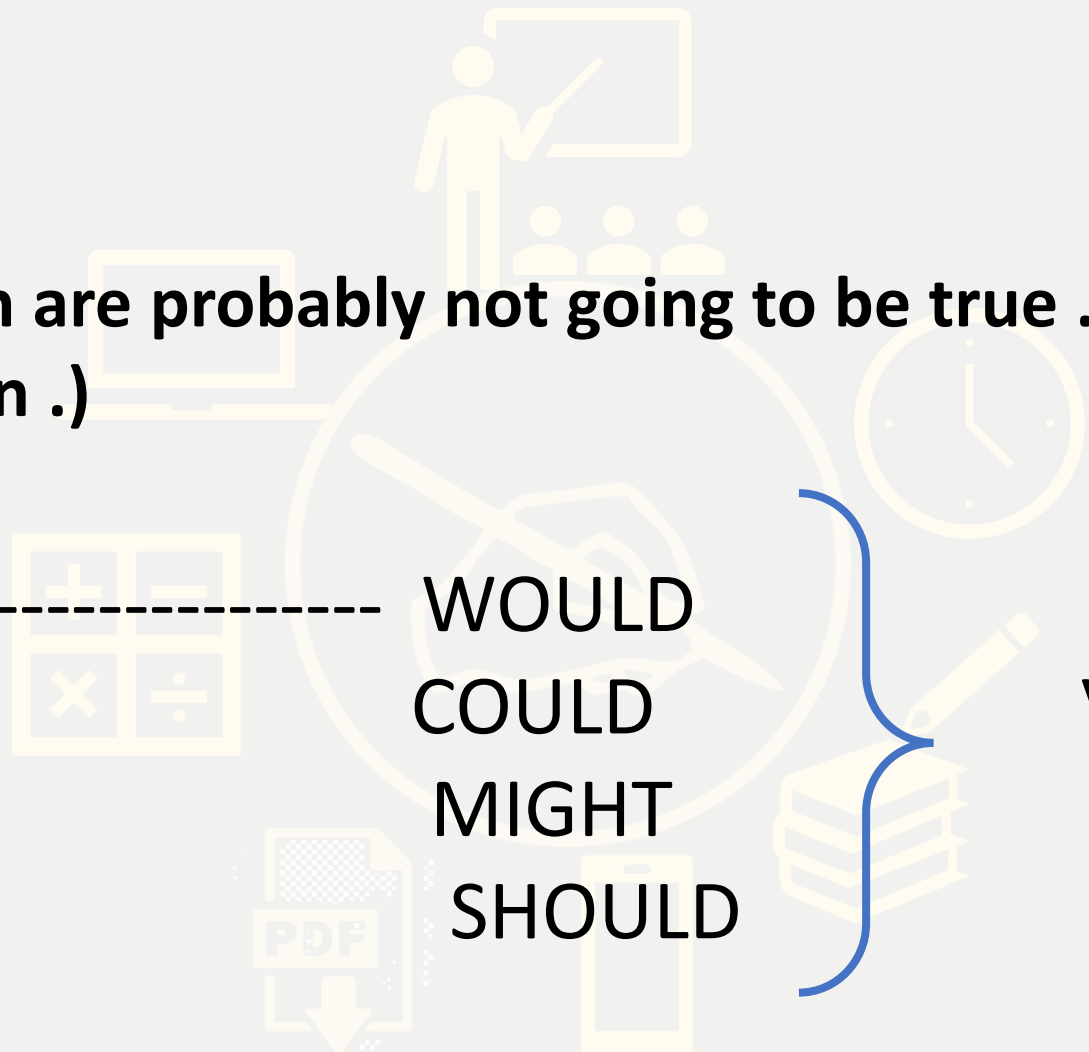
Talks about the things of future which are probably not going to be true .

IF + PAST PERFECT

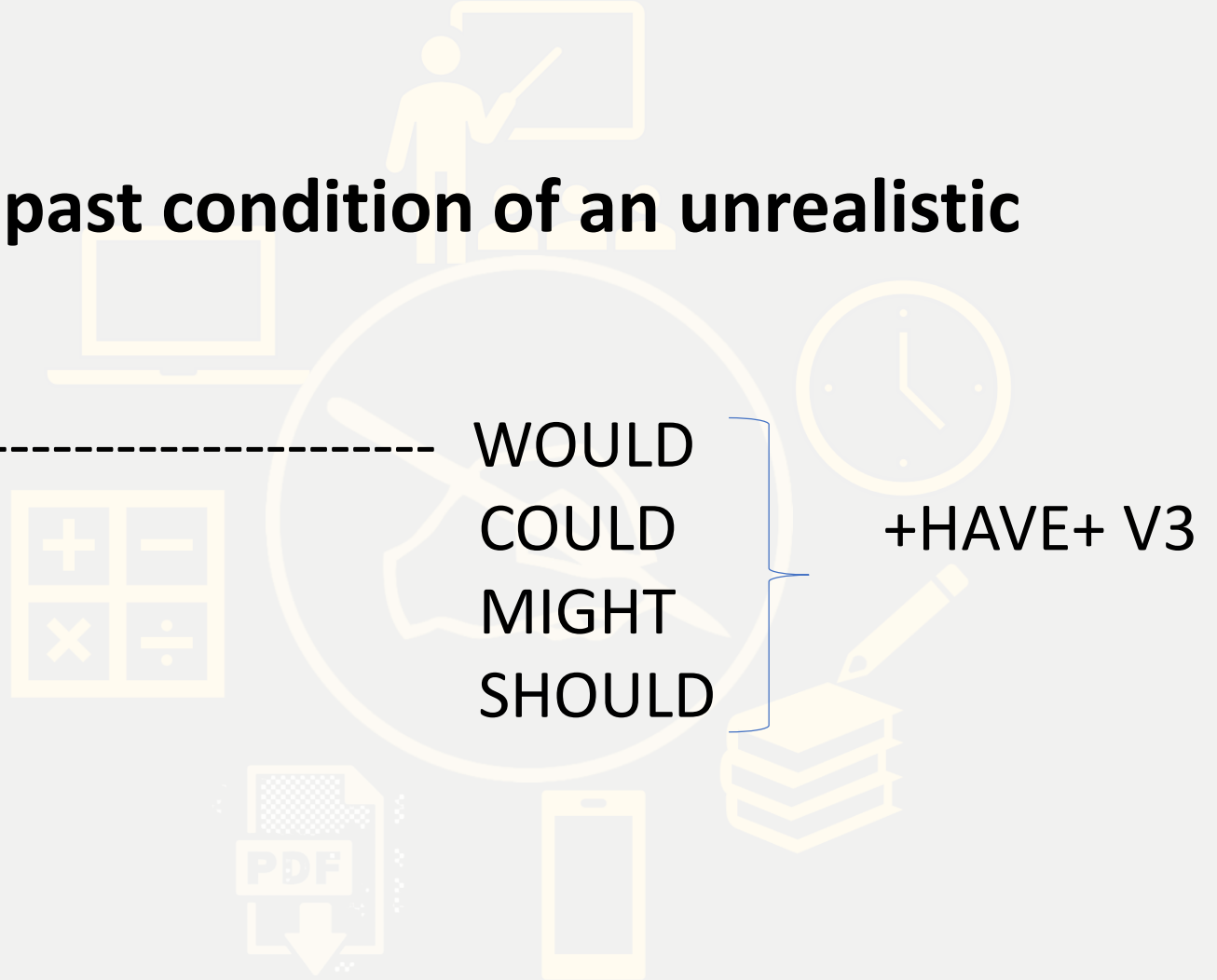
