Zero conditionals

scientific facts, general truths.

It expresses situations in which one things automatically happens after the other

In this case both clauses remain in simple present tense.

Second conditional

Talks about the things of future which are probably not going to be true . (if this happened, that would happen.)

IF + simple past -----

It is used to show or express the past condition of an unrealistic action or situation in the past .

IF + PAST PERFECT ------ WOULD COULD MIGHT SHOULD



1. If mr. sharma studied harder , he could have passed the SBI Clerk exam .









2. While giving speech the principal told us that , if there had not been so much traffic she would not have missed our fight .





3. Aditi had not missed our meeting if you had told her earlier about it .
