**Direct** – she says to me ," I like samosa" (exact words)

<u>Indirect</u> - she tells me that she likes samosa ( words by another speaker )

<u>Direct</u>- sita said to me, "I love you very much" <u>Indirect</u> – sita told me that she loved me very much"



#### **General rules:-**

- 1. Change of tense
- 2. Change of pronouns '
- 3. Change of words related
- to time and tense



#### 2. Change of pronouns :-

Reporting verb reported speech

Subject 1<sup>st</sup>

Object 2<sup>nd</sup>

No change 3<sup>rd</sup>

<u>Direct</u> – she said to me, "I have done my work " <u>Indirect</u> – she told me that she had done her work

<u>Direct</u> – ram said to her, "you have a good smile" <u>Indirect</u>- ram told her that she had a good smile.

Rahul asked where I worked



5. He says, "how do we survive?"

He asks how they survive.
