# WRITHE



**IMPERATIVE (Adjective)** – of vital importance; crucial.

- **Synonyms**- Mandatory, Compulsory, Essential

- **Antonyms** – Inessential, Uncritical, Insignificant

**Examples** – Free and open into pacific region is a global imperative.



**ARTICULATE (Verb)** – (साफ़ साफ़ बोलना) showing the ability to speak fluently and coherently.

- **Synonyms**- Enunciate, Express, Utter
- **Antonyms** – Ask, Question, Be quiet



**Examples** – He articulated his speech very well.

**FILLIP (Noun) – (प्रोत्साहन) something which acts as a stimulus or boost to an activity.**

- **Synonyms- Stimulus, Incentive, Boost**
- **Antonyms – Discourage**

**Examples – The halving of the automobile tax would provide a fillip to sales.**



**PROPENSITY (Noun) – (झुकाव)** an inclination or natural tendency to behave in a particular way.

- **Synonyms- Tendency, Inclination, Disposition**
- **Antonyms – Disinclination, Impotence**

**Examples - The students have a propensity for mischievous activities.**

**ENCROACHMENT (Noun) – (अठ्ठक्रमण) intrusion on a person's territory, rights, etc.**

- **Synonyms- Infringement Inroad,**
- **Antonyms – Decline, Halt, Retreat**

**Examples – Your entrance into our lives was an encroachment.**



MILIEU (Noun) – particular Environment you work or live in .

- Synonyms- Environment, Surroundings, Background
- Antonyms – confuse, no place , disregard

Examples – Despite my wife being brought up in a village milieu, she is very modern.

**AMELIORATION (Noun) – (सुधार) Improvement**

- **Synonyms- Reform, Betterment, Refinement**
- **Antonyms – Decline, Halt, Retreat**

**Examples – There is a need for amelioration in the existing laws**

SCOURGE (Noun) – (संकट) Calamity

- Synonyms- Curse, Terror
- Antonyms – Advantage, Benefit, Advantage, Reward

Examples – The scourge of mass unemployment has left everyone disheartened.
