

IMPERATIVE (Adjective) – of vital importance; crucial.

- Synonyms- Mandatory, Compulsory, Essential
- Antonyms – Inessential, Uncritical, Insignificant

Examples – 1. Free and open into pacific region is a global imperative.

ARTICULATE (Verb) – (साफ़ साफ़ बोलना) showing the ability to speak fluently and coherently.

- Synonyms- Enunciate, Express, Utter
- Antonyms – Ask, Question, Be quiet

Examples – He articulated his speech very well.

FILLIP (Noun) – (प्रोत्साहन) something which acts as a stimulus or boost to an activity.

- Synonyms- Stimulus, Incentive, Boost
- Antonyms – Discourage

Examples – 1. The halving of the automobile tax would provide a fillip to sales.

PROPENSITY (Noun) – (इुकव) an inclination or natural tendency to behave in a particular way.

- Synonyms- Tendency, Inclination, Disposition
- Antonyms – Disinclination, Impotence

Examples - 1. The students have a propensity for mischievous activities.

ENCROACHMENT (Noun) – (अठ्ठक्रमण) intrusion on a person's territory, rights, etc.

- Synonyms- Infringement Inroad,
- Antonyms – Decline, Halt, Retreat

Examples – 1. Your entrance into our lives was an encroachment.
