

develop a skin condition

I broke out in a rash after our camping trip.



Back away

go backwards, retreat When the man approached her, Julia backed away.



back down

to withdraw from your position or commitment

She agreed to go out for dinner. But when I suggested fast food, she **backed down** .



back up

make a copy of your computer data

You should always **back up** your data in case your computer breaks down.



back up

reverse (a car)

I need to back up to get out.



back someone up support someone

My wife **backed** me **up** over my decision to quit my job.
