- 1) RULE APOSTROPHE
- A) Words which don't end with (s,es,ies)-'s is used at the end of subject.
- B) Words which end with (s,es,ies)-' is used at the end of subject.
- C) Joint Possession-Apostrophe at the end of SECOND subject.
- NOTE- In case of SEPARATE POSSESSION –Apostrophe with BOTH SUBJECTS.
- D) COMPOUND WORDS Apostrophe at the end of Compound word.
- E) NON-LIVING THINGS-Apostrophe gives MEASUREMENT .

- 3) Some NOUNS are always used as UNCOUNTABLE Nouns ,they never use Any ARTICLE with them. THESE Nouns are-Scenery, Poetry, Furniture, Fuel, Information, Advice ,Knowledge, Traffic, Bread, Stationery, Crockery, Luggage ,Baggage, Breakage, Language, Money, Jewellery, Alphabet ,etc.
- To express them in COUNTABLE FORM ,certain PHRASES are used-Piece of ,Loaf of, Slice of, Bit of, Item of ,Kind of, Article of etc.

- 7) Some Nouns are always used as PLURALS .These Nouns are-
- Police, Clergy, Cattle ,Cavalry , Tenantry, Peasantry , Women , Children, Gentry , Infantry, Cannon , Poultry, etc.

NOTE - Nouns ending with –ics, when used as – 1)SUBJECT of Sentence – SINGULAR

2)Possession is shown over them or when show calculations, mathematical abilities , sums of physics , economic facts-PLURAL .
