**The Flower smells sweet. (Right)**

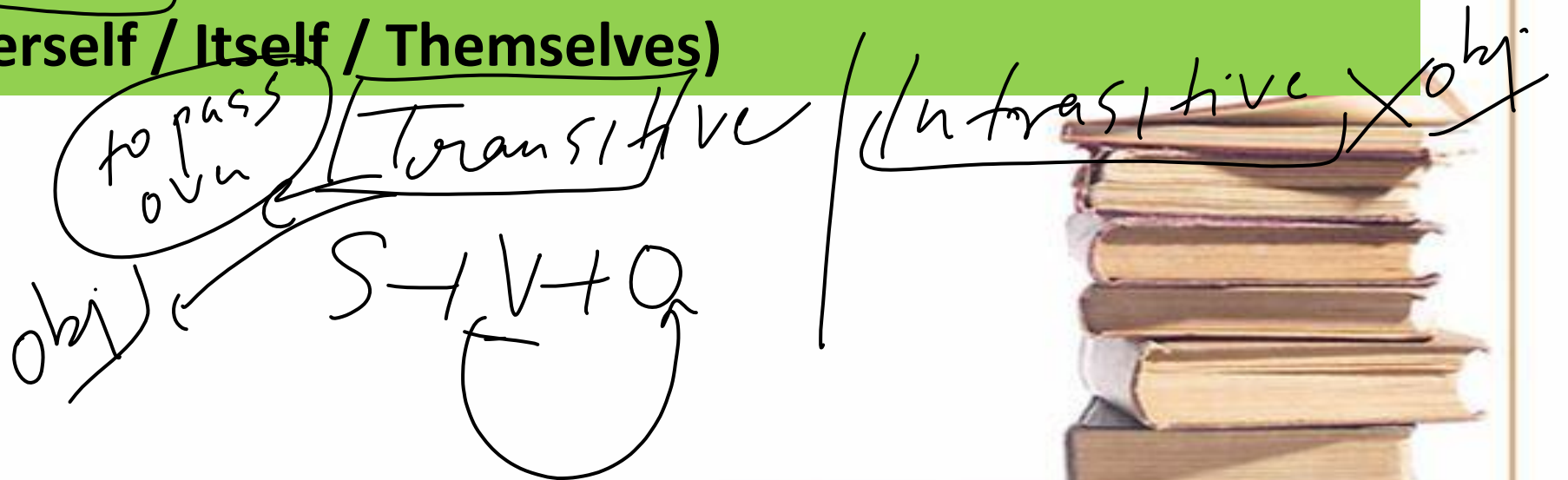
~~Rose is smelling sweet~~

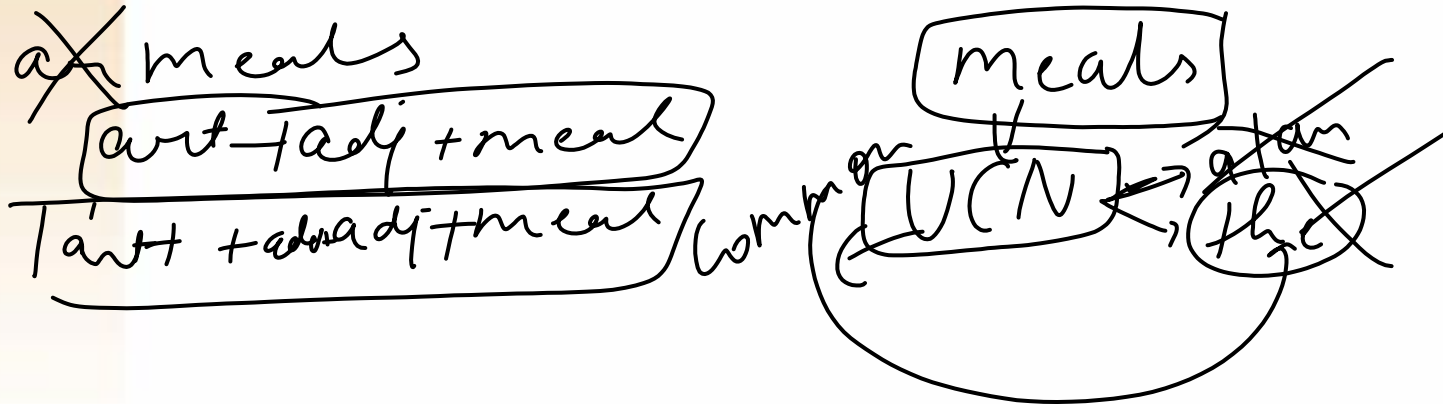




- I introduced her to the Principal.
