1. Foment (Verb): भड़काना

Meaning: instigate or stir up (an undesirable or violent sentiment or course of action)

Synonyms: provoke, incite, trigger

Antonyms: calm, cease, constrain

Sentence: The politician tried to foment unrest among the people by spreading false rumors.

2. Garner (Verb): इकट्ठा करना

Meaning: to gather or collect something, especially information or support

Synonyms: collect, gather, amass, assemble, accumulate

Antonyms: disperse, scatter, distribute

Sentence: She was able to garner enough support to win the election.





What is the antonym of **Euphemism** ??

उ. Euphemism (Noun): प्रियोक्ति


Meaning: a word or phrase used to avoid saying an unpleasant or offensive word

Synonyms: polite term, substitute, understatement, indirect expression

Antonyms: directness, straightforwardness, terseness

Sentence: 1. "Senior citizen" is a euphemism for "old person".

2. Instead of saying that someone has died, people often use the euphemism "passed away" to soften the blow of the news.

4. Buttress (Verb): समर्थन करना

Meaning: to give support to or strengthen something

Synonyms: support, brace, reinforce, strengthen

Antonyms: undermine, weaken

Sentence: The new evidence served to buttress his argument for the defendant's innocence.





What is the synonym of Relinquish ??

5. Relinquish (Verb) : त्यागना

Meaning: voluntarily cease to keep or claim; give up

Synonyms: surrender, render, abandon

Antonyms: retain, keep, withhold

Sentence: He had to relinquish his position as CEO due to his health issues.





What is the antonym of Cryptic??

6. Cryptic (Adjective) : गुप्त

Meaning: having a meaning that is mysterious or obscure.

Synonyms: enigmatic, mysterious, hard to understand

Antonyms: understandable, clear, plain, transparent

Sentence: The message was written in cryptic code that only a few people could decipher.

7. Regale (Verb) : मनोरंजन करना

Meaning: to entertain someone with stories, jokes, food, drink, or pleasant talk

Synonyms: Entertain, Amuse, Delight, Please

Antonyms: Displease, Disgust

Sentence: She regaled her guests with stories of her travels and served them a delicious dinner.

Correct Answer: 1. intimidate






8. Peregrination (Noun) : सफ़र, यात्रा

Synonyms: travels, voyages, journey

Sentence: The author's peregrination through the countryside inspired his latest novel.

Sentence: Mahatma Gandhi was a luminary in the Indian independence movement.


10. Fillip (Noun) : प्रोत्साहन
