Sentence: The journalist will delve into the matter to find the truth.

2. Elude (Verb) : बच निकलना, टाल जाना

Meaning: To escape from or avoid someone or something, typically in a skillful or cunning way.

Synonyms: evade, avoid, escape, dodge

Antonyms: confront, face, encounter, meet,

Sentence: The thief managed to elude the police by sneaking out through the back door.

3. Spurious (Verb) : जाली, नकली

Meaning: false or fake; not genuine or authentic

Antonyms: genuine, authentic, real, valid, true

Sentence: The salesman tried to sell me a spurious watch claiming it was a luxury brand.

4. Solatium (Noun): मुआवज़ा

Meaning: a payment made to someone who has suffered loss or injury, compensation, consolation

Sentence: The company provided a solatium to the families of the workers who were injured in the accident.

6. Inculcate (Verb) : अंतर्निविष्ठ करना

Meaning: to instill or teach an idea, habit, or skill by persistent instruction (to fix beliefs or ideas in someone's mind, especially by repeating them often)

Synonyms: instill, implant,

indoctrinate, teach

Antonyms: unlearn, forget, neglect

Sentence: Parents play a crucial role in inculcating good values in their children.


7. Myriad (Noun, Adj.): असंख्य, अनगिनत, विविधता

Meaning: countless or extremely great number, a large variety or assortment

Synonyms: countless, infinite, numerous

Antonyms: limited, few, finite

Sentence: There is myriad of stars in the sky on a clear night.

Sentence: She brazenly asked for a raise after only two weeks on the job.

10. Stymie (Verb.): बाधा डालना

Meaning: to prevent something from happening or someone from achieving a purpose

Synonyms: Hinder, obstruct, impede, thwart, hamper, block

Sentence: The lack of funding stymied the progress of the research project.
