- Source ✓

- duration of an action with respect to another.

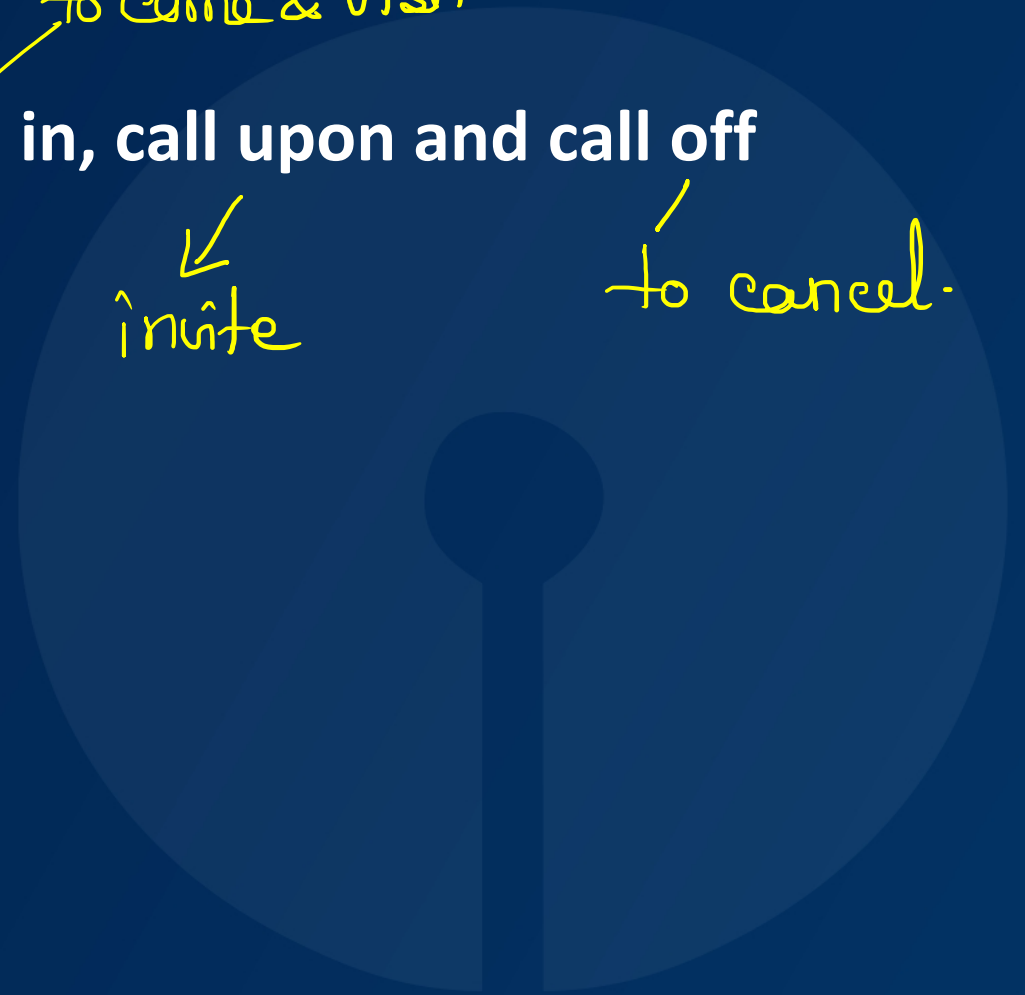
