WORDS WITH PICTURE



1. Unequivocal (Adj.) : स्पष्ट, असंदिग्ध

Meaning: Clear, definite, leaving no room for doubt or ambiguity.

Synonyms: Clear-cut, Unambiguous, Explicit
Ant Implicit

Antonyms: Ambiguous, Uncertain, Indeterminate

Sentence: Her unequivocal statement left no doubt about her stance on the matter.





The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC)'s latest decision, to extend the pause in the Reserve Bank of India (RBI)'s monetary tightening while staying focused on the withdrawal of accommodation, reflects the rate setting panel's reassuring resolve to keep inflation front and centre of its approach to policy. RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das was unequivocal in asserting that "the best contribution of monetary policy to the economy's ability to realise its potential is by ensuring price stability". 2. Unabated (Adj.) : निरंतर, बढ़ती हुई

Meaning: **Without any reduction in intensity or force, continuing at full strength.**

Synonyms: **Unrestrained, Unrelenting, Uninterrupted**

Antonyms: **Abated, Diminished, Decreased**

Sentence: **The storm continued unabated throughout the night, causing widespread damage.**

Specifically, Mr. Das flagged the spatial and temporal distribution of rainfall during this monsoon in the wake of El Niño conditions, unabated geopolitical tensions, uncertainty over international commodity prices including those of sugar, rice and crude oil, and the volatility in global financial markets as upside risks to the MPC's inflation projections. 3. Indictment (Noun) : अभियोग

Meaning: The act of accusing someone of a crime; a formal charge or accusation of a serious crime

Synonyms: Accusation, Charge, Allegation

Antonyms: Acquittal, Exoneration

Sentence: The grand jury returned an indictment against the suspect for the murder charges.





The indictment of former U.S. President Donald Trump by a federal grand jury in the investigation by the Department of Justice (DoJ) into his alleged mishandling of hundreds of classified documents creates an unprecedented political situation ahead of the 2024 American presidential election. This is the first time in U.S.



4. Incumbent (Adj.) : अवलंबी

Meaning: Imposed as a duty or obligation

Synonyms: Obligatory, Required, Mandatory, Binding

Antonyms: Optional, Voluntary, Noncompulsory

Sentence: It is incumbent upon all citizens to vote in the elections.





Mr. Trump is not only a former President but also the key potential rival of Mr. Biden, the incumbent, in 2024. Mr. Trump has already seized the political angle, calling the cases a Democratic witch hunt and asking his supporters “not to surrender” the country “to the radical Left”. As he seems determined to use the cases for political mobilization, America’s divided polity is set to see further



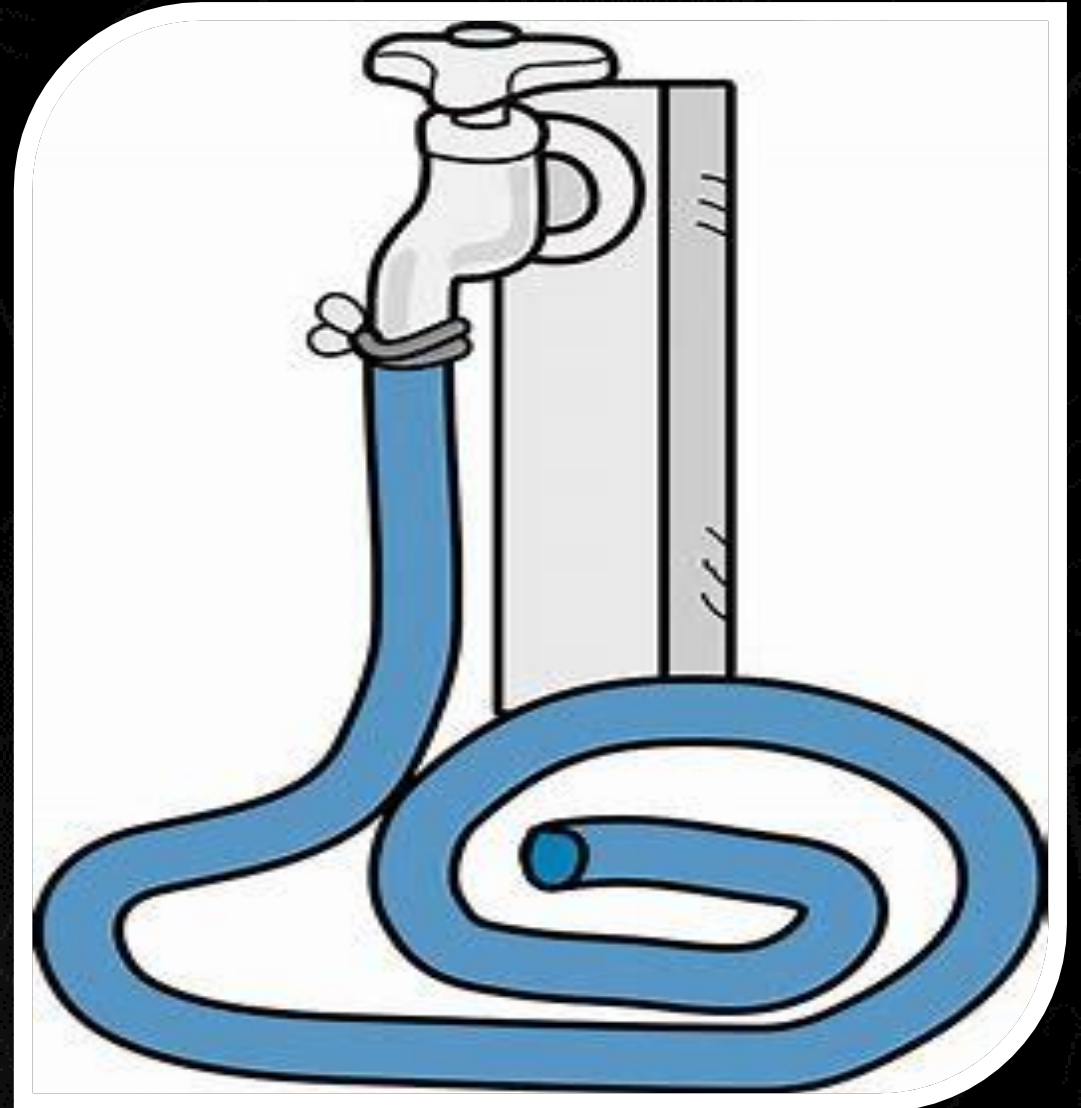
5. Watertight (Adj.) : निर्विवाद

Meaning: (of an argument or account) unable to be disputed or questioned

Synonyms: Indisputable, Unquestionable

Antonyms: Flawed, Disputable

Sentence: Their plan of action for the problem was watertight.

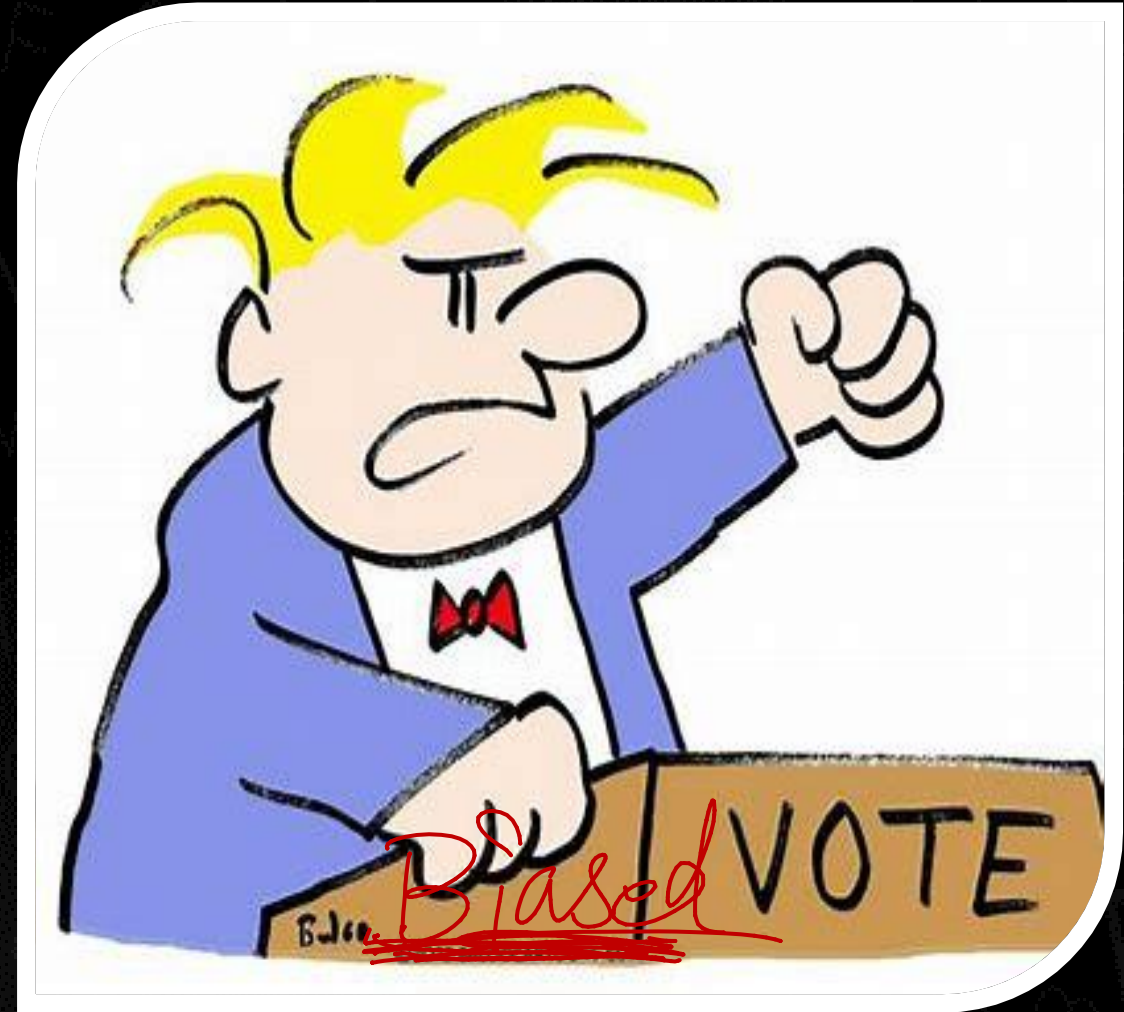
6. Partisan (Adj.) : पक्षपाती

Meaning: Biased or showing strong support for a particular party, group, or cause

Synonyms: biased, prejudiced, partial
neutral

Antonyms: unbiased, impartial, fair

Sentence: The media accused the journalist of writing a partisan article favoring one political party.

7. Moonlighting (Verb) : अतिरिक्त काम करना

Meaning: Practice of working a second job, especially secretly or at night, in addition to one's regular job.

Synonyms: Second job, sideline, side hustle

Antonyms: Primary job, Full-time job, primary employment, main occupation

Sentence: Tom was caught moonlighting at a local restaurant, even though his contract prohibited him from taking a second job.





8. Muddled (Adjective): **उलझा हुआ**

Meaning: Confused or mixed up, not clear or well-organized

Synonyms: Confused, Jumbled, Befuddled, Disordered

Antonyms: Clear, Organized, Orderly, Coherent

Sentence: The muddled instructions made it difficult for the students to complete the assignment correctly.





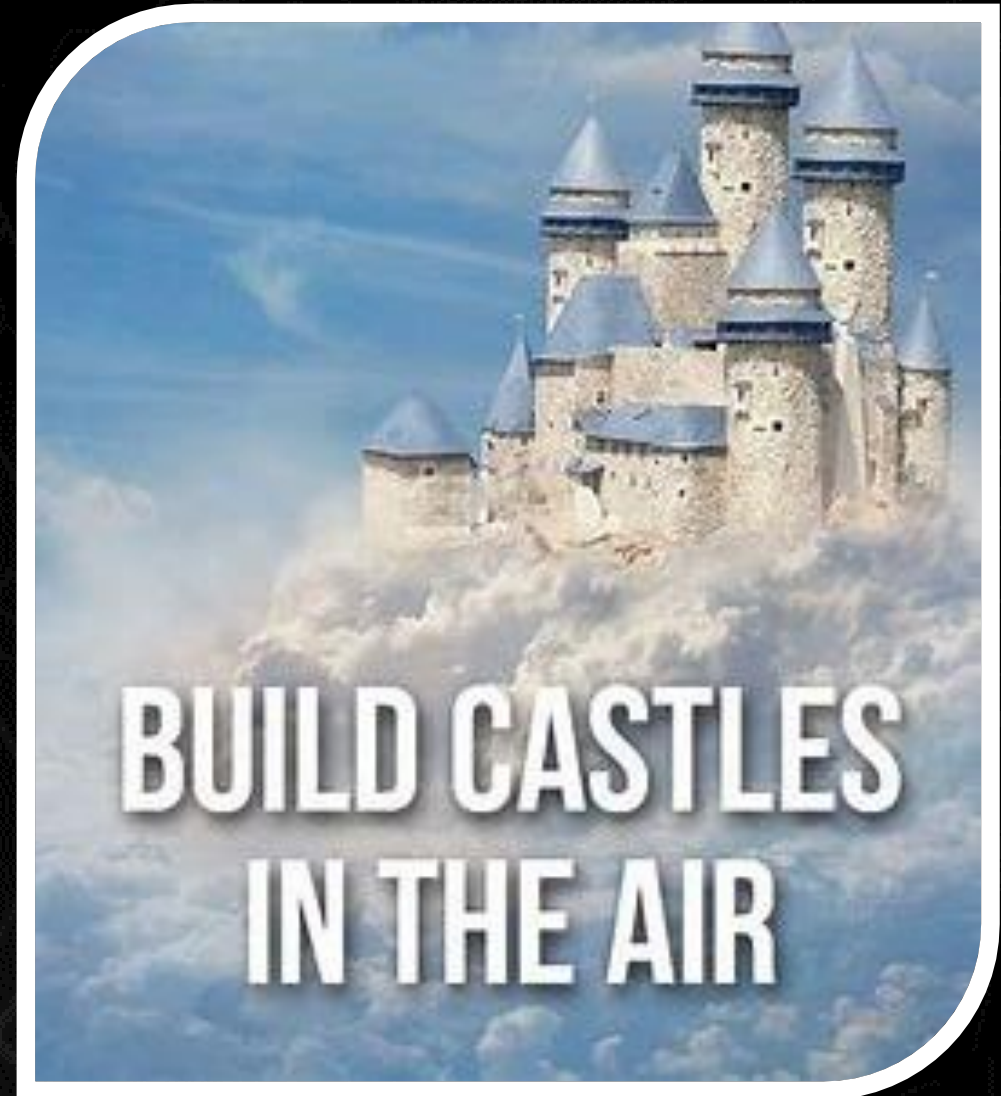
9. Build castles in the air (Idiom)

Meaning: To create dreams, hopes, or plans that are impossible, unrealistic, or have very little chance of succeeding.

Synonyms: Daydream, Fantasize, Visualize

Antonym: Be realistic, Stay grounded

Sentence: John was always building castles in the air about becoming a millionaire without doing any hard work.





10. Whistle in the dark (Idiom)

Meaning: To try to remain brave or hopeful in a difficult or dangerous situation

Synonyms: Put on a brave face, maintain a positive outlook

Antonym: give up hope, lose heart, succumb to despair.

Sentence: Even though she was lost and alone in the dark forest, she tried to whistle in the dark and keep a positive attitude, hoping that someone would come to her rescue.
