Synonyms: Noise, Clamour Antonyms: harmony, tranquillity

(n.) a mixture of harsh, unpleasant sounds

Example sentence: The construction site was filled with the cacophony of drilling machines, hammering, and loud shouts.

CACOPHONY

(n.) a mixture of harsh, unpleasant sounds

Scorching (Adjective)

Meaning: (तपता हुआ)

Synonyms: blazing, searing Antonyms: freezing, chilly SCORCHING extremely hot (adj.)

Example sentence: The scorching sun made it difficult to stay outside for too long without shade. SCORCHING extremely hot (adj.)


