WORDS WITH PICTURE

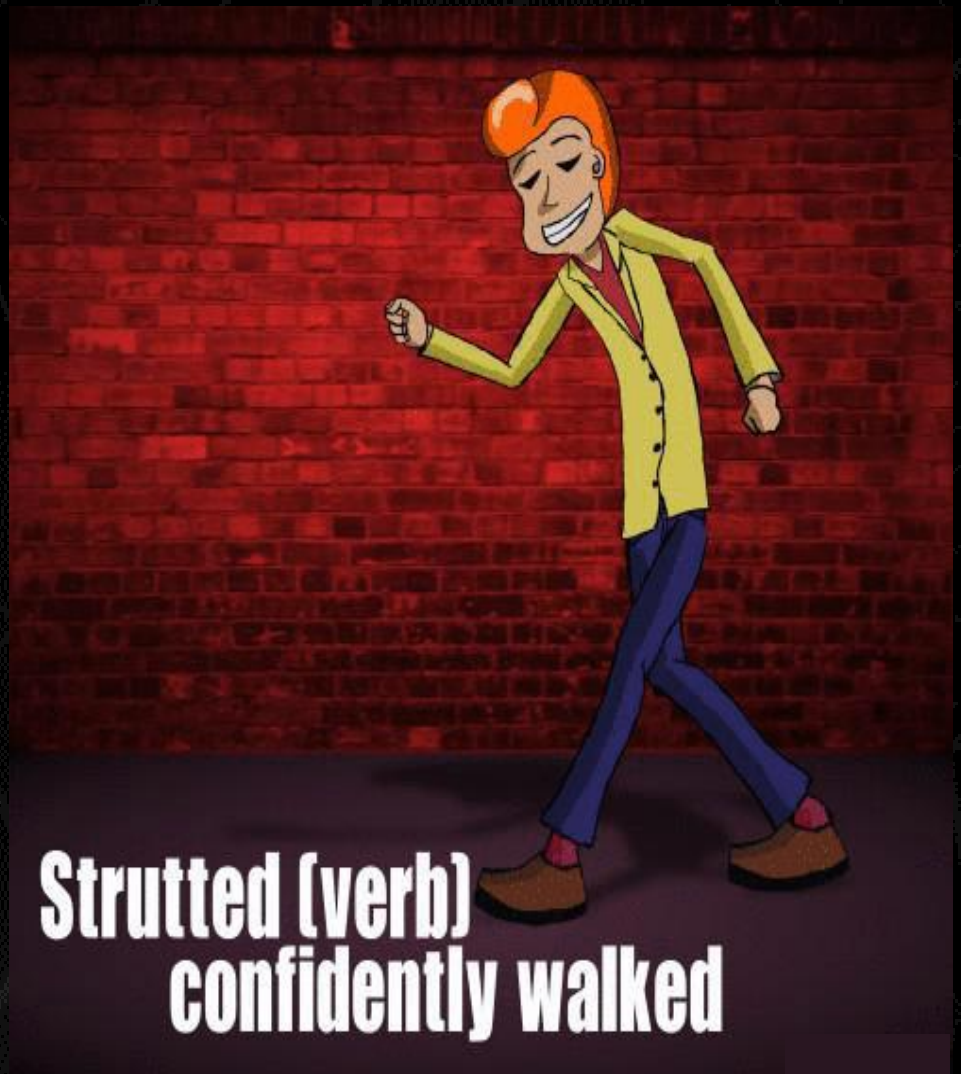


Strutted (Verb)

paraded

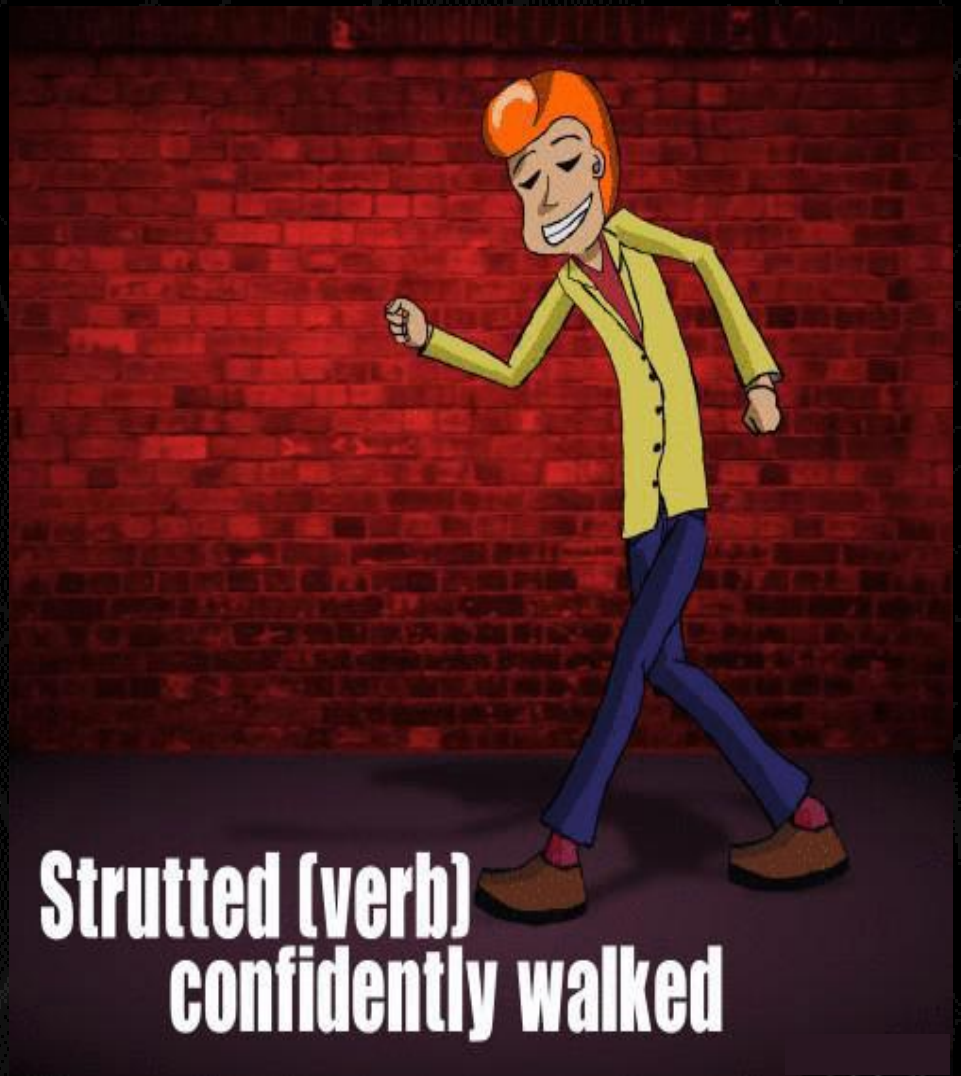
Antonyms: **shuffled,**

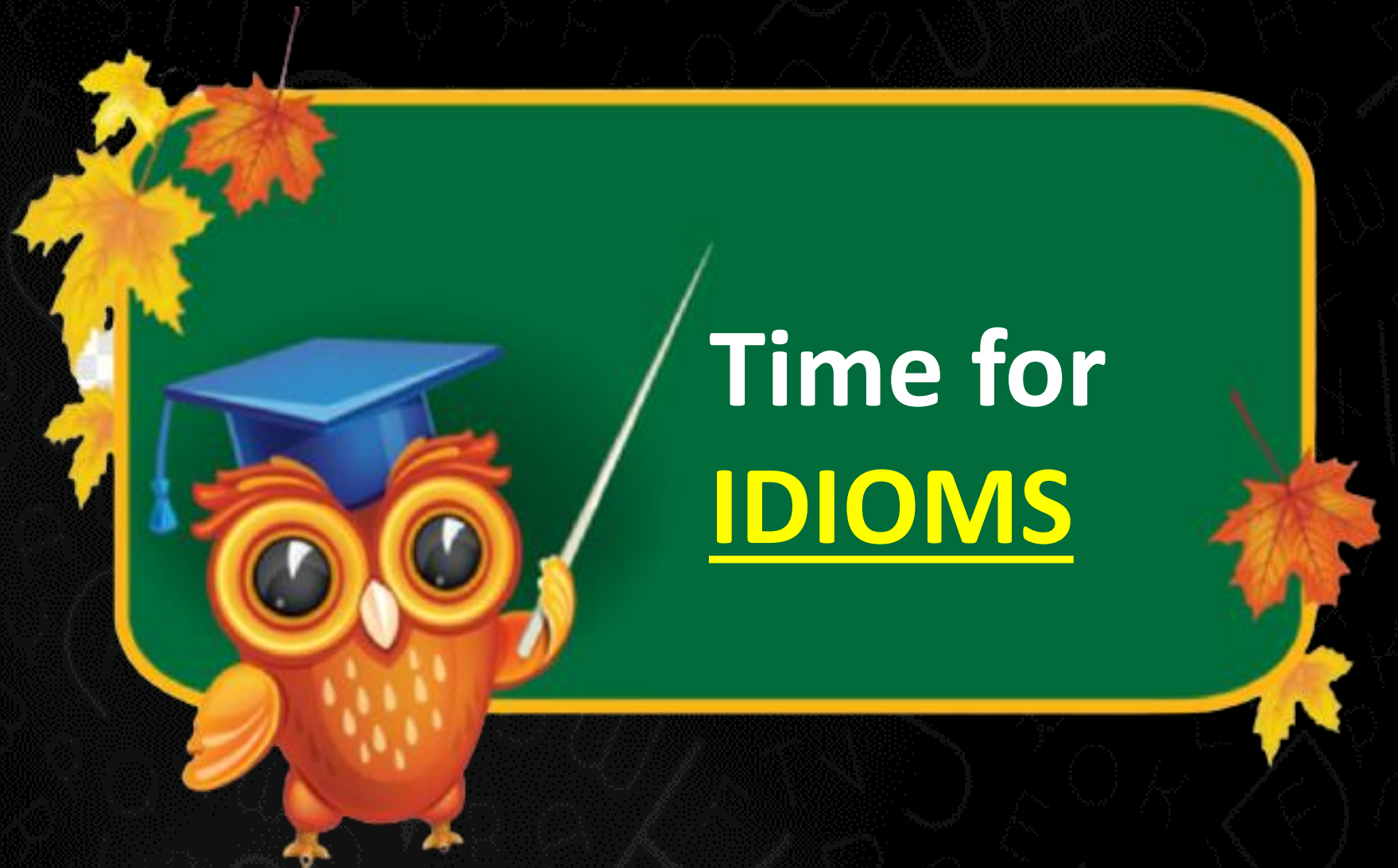
