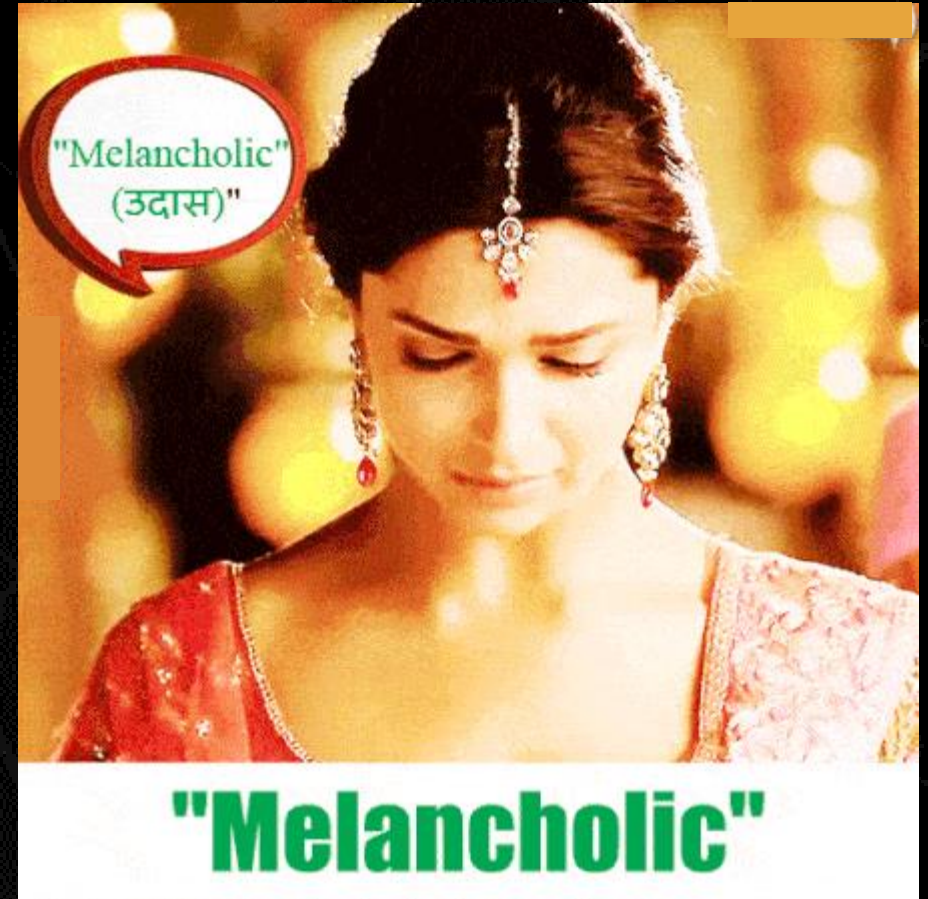


Melancholic (Adjective)

gloomy, depressed

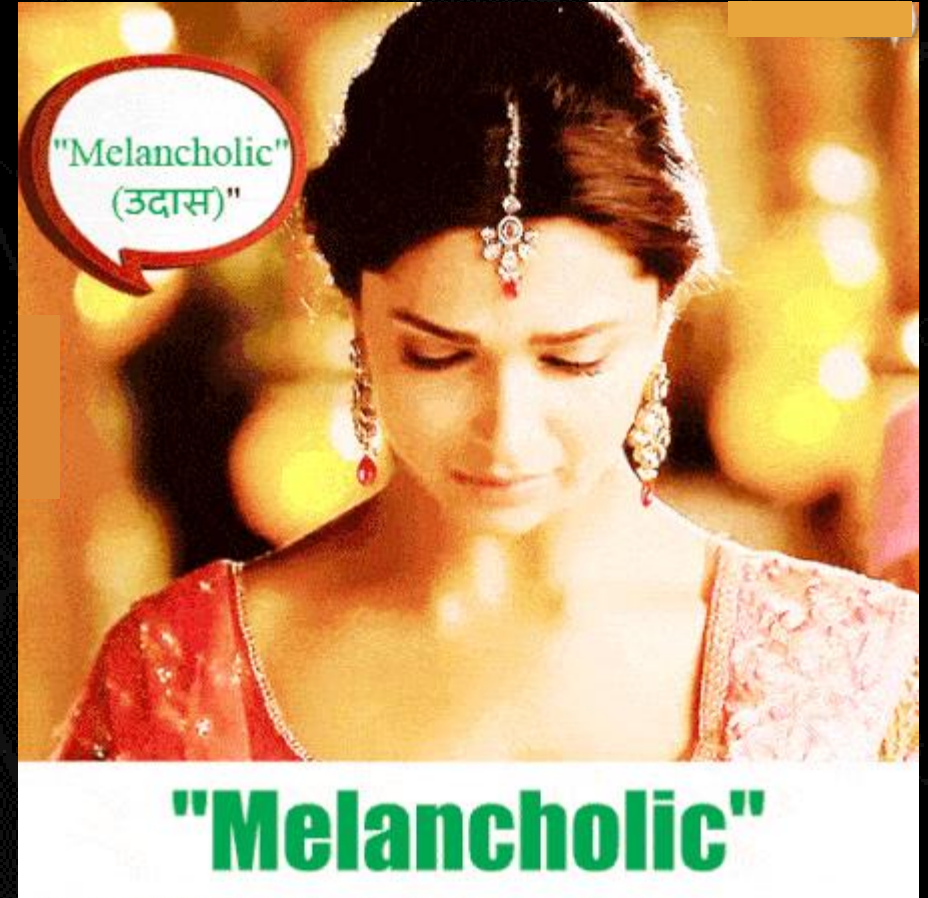
Antonyms: happy,

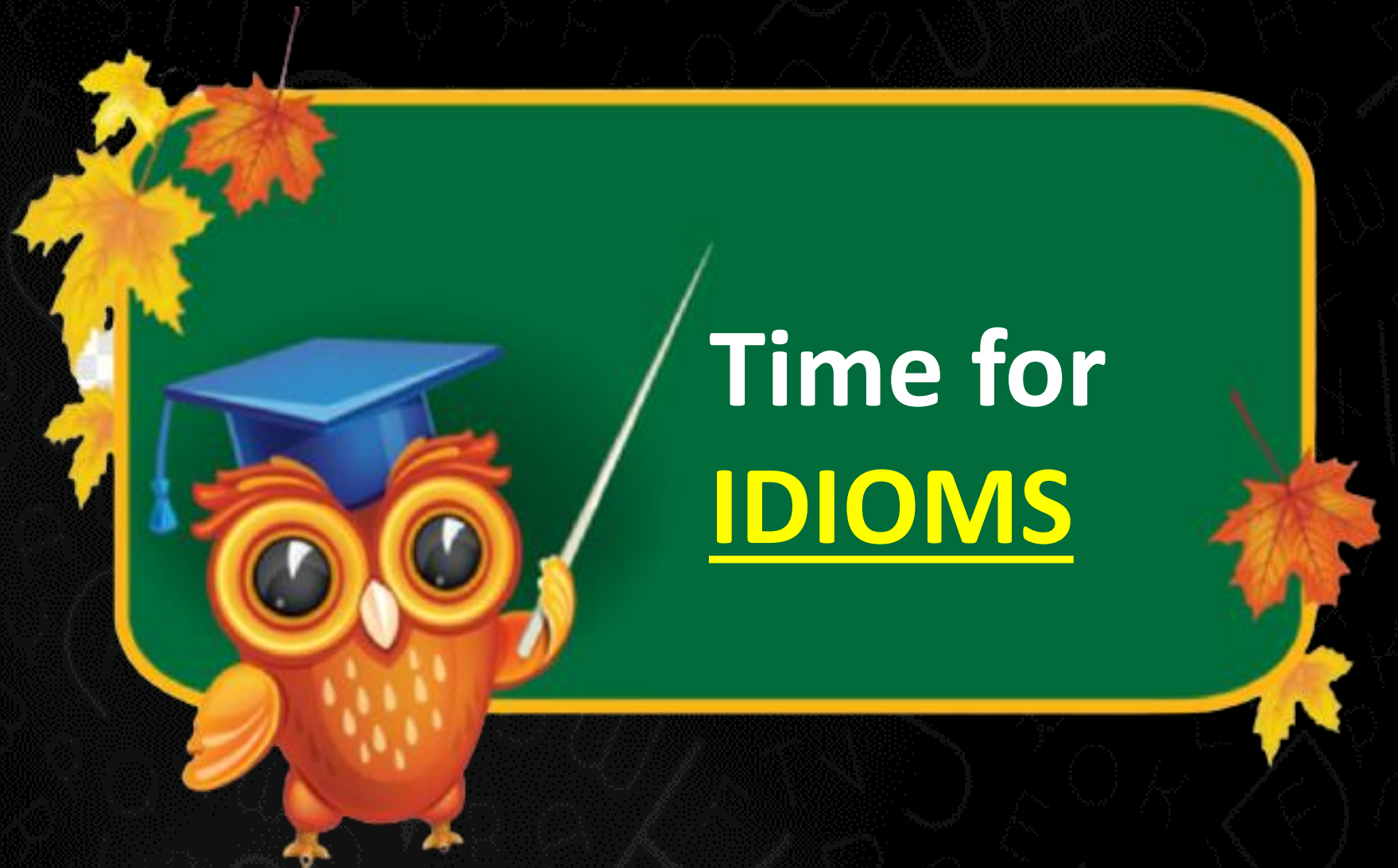
