16 killed, many missing as landslip triggered by heavy rain buries village in Maharashtra's Raigad

PUNE

At least 16 persons were killed and 21 injured after a landslip induced by incessant rain buried the hamlet of Irshalwadi in Raigad district, 65 km from Mumbai, authorities said on Thursday.

Tragedy struck the mountainous village in Khalapur tehsil when the rockfall buried more than half of the 48 homes between 10.30 p.m. and 11 p.m. on Wednesday night.

The death toll is expected to rise significantly as only about 100 of the hamlet's population of 228 have been accounted for,

authorities said.

The lack of proper motorable road to the village proved a vital factor in delaying rescue operations as heavy machinery such as earth movers and excavators could not reach the site. This compelled rescue teams from the National Disaster Response Force and the State Disaster Response Force, besides members of NGOs and trekkers' outfits, to perform operations manually.

After nearly 16 hours of rescue operations since the early hours of Thursday, poor visibility, coupled with gusty winds, intense downpour, thick mud, and the potential dangers of more mudslips, forced the rescue teams to call a halt by 4.30 p.m.

CM reaches spot

Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, who had been monitoring rescue operations from the base camp at Chouk since early morning, made the arduous hour-and-a-half trek to the disaster spot.


"We are still trying to corroborate the actual figures as some people from the village were away when disaster struck. It is an extremely unfortunate incident. The government is firmly behind the villagers in their hour of grief. We have announced a compensation of ₹5 lakh for the kin of each of the deceased, while the State will bear medical expenses of all the injured," the Chief Minister said.

Mr. Shinde said 50 to 60 shipping containers had been arranged for the survivors as temporary shelters and that they were being moved to safer zones.

Electrocution (Noun)



Two die from electrocution in separate incidents

NEW DELHI

Two men in their early 20s died from electrocution in the city in separate incidents, in a span of 48 hours, the police said on Thursday.

A 22-year-old motor mechanic, Danish, died in south-east Delhi's Kalindi Kunj on Thursday while repairing a submersible electric water pump at a house, the police said.

DCP (South East) Rajesh
Deo said the pump installed at an underground
tank in Vishwakarma Colony was damaged during
the recent floods. "The incident took place around
2.30 p.m. The pump was
being removed for repairs,
but the electric wire attached to it was left loose.
As soon as he came in contact with the wire, he got
electrocuted," he added.
He was rushed to a hospital

where doctors declared him brought dead, the DCP said, adding that an FIR under IPC Section 304A (causing death by negligence) has been registered.

In another incident, a 24-year-old man died from electrocution while working out at a gym in Rohini's Sector 15. The deceased was identified as Saksham Purthi, a resident of Sector 19, Rohini. According to the police, the incident took place on Tuesday at 7.15 a.m. at the Gymplex Fitness Zone. The gym owner, Anubhav Duggal, 30, was arrested and released on bail later. A case has been filed under relevant sections of the IPC.

Keshav Narang, 30, a resident of Sector 15, an eyewitness, said, "Saksham had just finished working out and sat between two treadmills to rest. As soon as he placed his hand on one of them, he got electrocuted."


