convenient



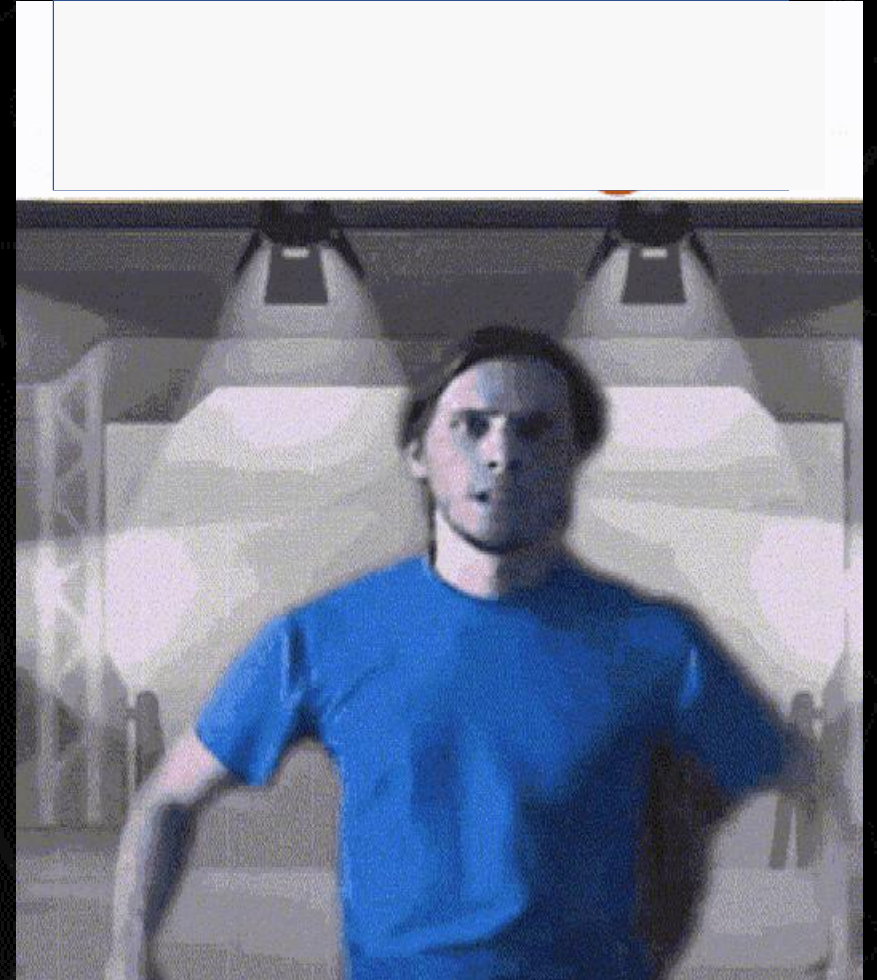


## 4. INSURGENT (NOUN)

## 5. HERCULEAN (ADJECTIVE)

Meaning: (अत्यंत कठिन):  
**arduous**

Synonyms: **gruelling** ,  
**laborious**

Antonyms: **easy** , **convenient**







## 6. PATRONIZE (VERB)

Meaning: (नीचा करना): look down on

Synonyms: talk down to, put down

Antonyms: praise





## 7. GALL (VERB)

Meaning: (खिजाना): irritate

Synonyms: annoy, vex

Antonyms: mollify





## 8. FIERY (ADJECTIVE)

Meaning: (उत्साही):

**passionate**

Synonyms: **impassioned,**  
**ardent**

Antonyms: **bland**





## 9. Conflagration (Noun):

भयंकर आग

Meaning: A large, destructive fire that causes significant damage to property and/or people

Synonyms: Blaze, Flames





10. Avid (Adjective) : उत्सुक

Meaning: **having or showing keen interest or enthusiasm for something**

Synonyms: **enthusiastic, passionate, eager, zealous**

Antonyms: **indifferent, uninterested**
