cajole

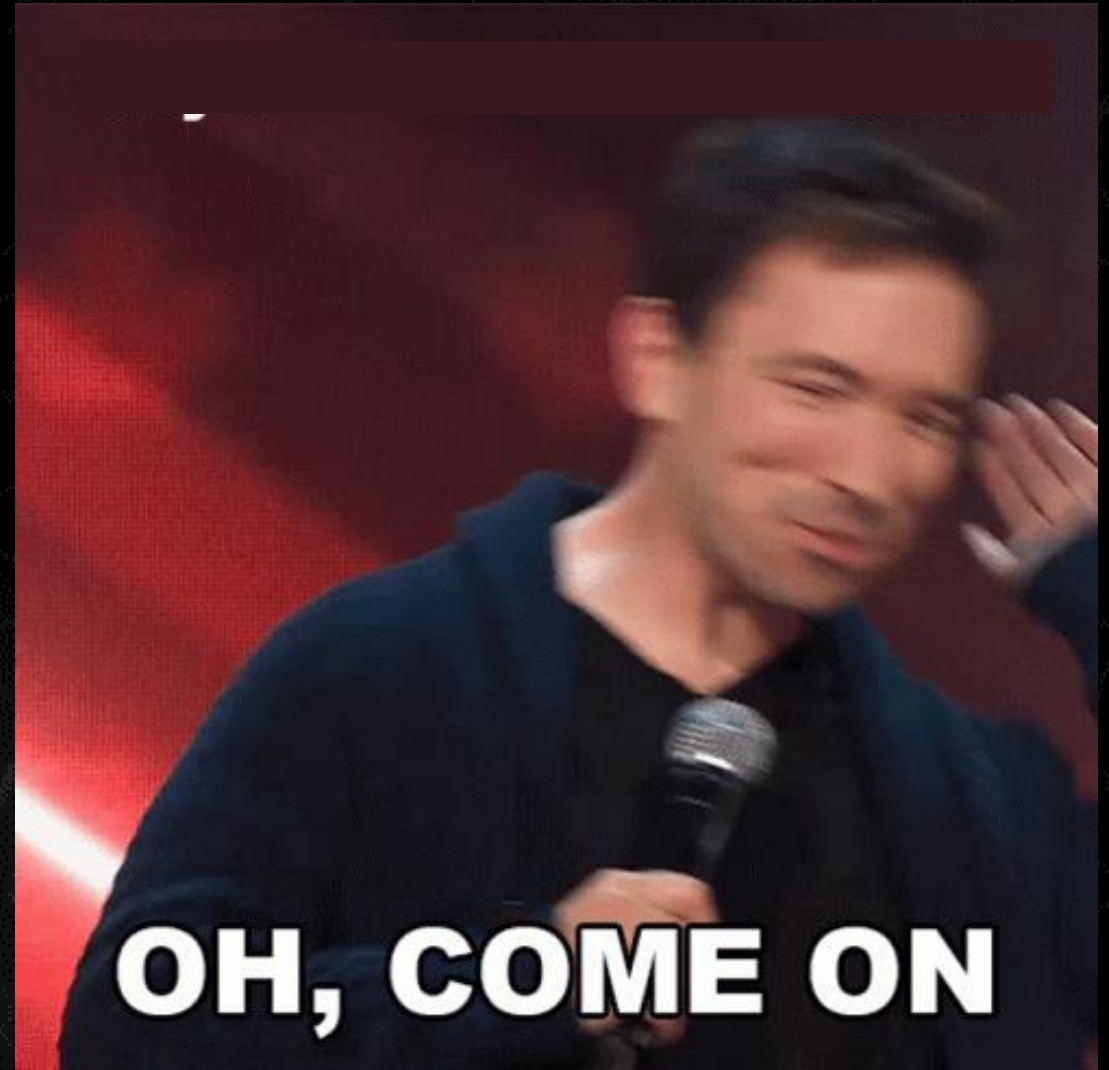
Antonyms: dissuade

STRIFE (NOUN)

Meaning: (झगड़ा)

Synonyms: friction,
discord

Antonyms: harmony





Example sentence:

The country was torn apart by political strife, leading to protests and unrest.





SABOTAGE (VERB)

Meaning: (नुक्रसान
पहुंचाना)

Synonyms: **vandalize,**
destroy

Antonyms: **strengthen**





Example sentences:

The rival team attempted to sabotage our chances of winning by spreading false rumors about our star player.

4. Intimidate

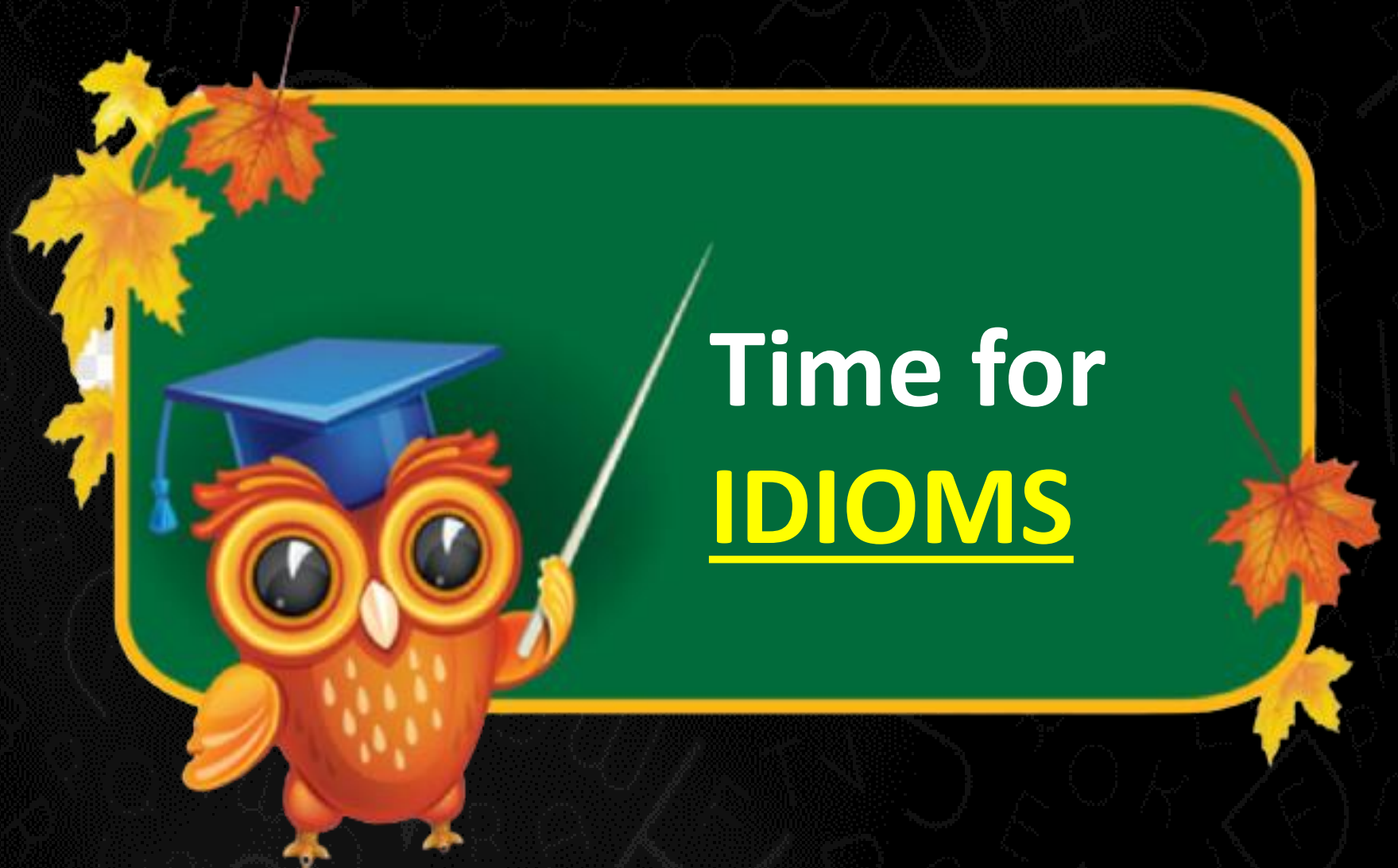


Definition: To frighten or threaten someone so that they will do what you want
