Example sentence: Bob's complacency in his current job is evident; he never seeks out new challenges opportunities for growth.






COAX (VERB)


Meaning: (फुसलाना)

Antonyms: dissuade




**Example sentence:** The mother tried to coax her child into eating some vegetables making funny faces.



## STRIFE (NOUN)


Meaning: (झगड़ा)

Synonyms: friction, discord
Antonyms: harmony





Example sentence:
The country was
torn apart by political
strife, leading to
protests and unrest.





## SABOTAGE (VERB)

Meaning: (नुक्रसान पहुंचाना)

Synonyms: vandalize, destroy
Antonyms: strengthen



**Example sentences:** The rival team attempted to sabotage our chances of winning by spreading false rumors about our star player.

Usage: Diana couldn't conceal her envy of Dev's success.


### 4. Intimidate




**Definition:** To frighten or threaten someone so that they will do what you want
