




VOCABULARY - ROOT WORDS



DEFINITION

- A root word is a word or word part that forms the basis of new words through the addition of <u>prefixes</u> and <u>suffixes</u>. It's not a complete word. Understanding the meanings of common roots can help you work out the meanings of new words as you encounter them.
- Once you pull off any prefixes or suffixes, the root is usually what remains. For example, "egotist" has a root word of "ego" plus the suffix -ist. "Acting" has the root word "act" and ing is merely the suffix.


EGOTISTICAL AND NARCISSISTIC

EGOIST VS EGOTIST


